**MOTION TO CONSOLIDATE OF
DUQUESNE LIGHT COMPANY**

TO THE PENNSYLVANIA PUBLIC UTILITY COMMISSION:

Duquesne Light Company (“Duquesne Light” or the “Company”) hereby moves to consolidate the above-captioned matters pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 5.81. The Company requests that the proceedings be consolidated for purposes of hearings and adjudication because they raise overlapping issues of fact and law.

As explained herein, these proceedings involve two complaints filed by Valerie Hobson (“Complainants”) against Duquesne Light. The respective Formal Complaints filed at Docket Nos. C-2026-3060330 (“First Complaint”) and C-2026-3060467 (“Second Complaint”) involve electric service to the same account and address, and raise similar requests for relief arising out of the same alleged incidents. Therefore, in the interests of administrative efficiency and judicial economy, the Company believes that these matters should be consolidated.

In support of this Motion, the Company states as follows:

I. BACKGROUND

1. Duquesne Light is a “public utility,” an “electric distribution company,” and a “default service provider” as defined in Sections 102 and 2803 of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. §§ 102, 2803.

2. Duquesne Light was electronically served with the above-captioned Formal Complaints on February 11, 2026 and February 12, 2026.

3. The issues raised in the Formal Complaints include allegations that the Complainant’s December 2025 bill is incorrect and both involve a request for a payment arrangement.

II. MOTION TO CONSOLIDATE

4. The Company herein respectfully requests that the First and Second Complaints be consolidated for the purposes of hearings and adjudication because they raise common issues of law and fact.

5. Both Complaints list the same Complainant name, address, email address, and phone numbers.

6. Both Complaints concern electric service at the same service address to the same electric service account. (First Complaint ¶ 1; Second Complaint ¶ 1.)

7. In both Complaints, the core issue the Complainant alleges is an incorrect bill issued in December 2025. (First Complaint ¶¶ 4-5; Second Complaint ¶¶ 4-5).

8. In both Complaints, the Complainant requests a payment agreement, among other relief. (First Complaint ¶ 4; Second Complaint ¶ 4).

9. If these cases were to proceed independently and not be consolidated, there would be substantial overlapping issues of law and fact in the cases.


10. Consolidation of these proceedings would promote the efficient use of the time and resources of the Parties and the Commission, and may avoid unnecessary costs or delay in resolving the Complaints.

11. For these reasons, the Company respectfully requests that these proceedings be consolidated for purposes of hearings and adjudication.

III. CONCLUSION

WHEREFORE, Duquesne Light Company respectfully requests that the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission enter an order consolidating the Formal Complaint proceedings at C-2026-3060330 and C-2026-3060467 for purposes of hearings and adjudication.
