**PREHEARING CONFERENCE MEMORANDUM
OF BUX-MONT TRANSPORTATION, INC., EASTON COACH COMPANY,
SUBURBAN TRANSIT NETWORK, INC., AND TRI COUNTY TRANSIT SERVICE,
INC.**

TO THE HONORABLE ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE CHAD L. ALLENSWORTH:

Bux-Mont Transportation, Inc. (“Bux-Mont”), Easton Coach Company (“Easton”), Suburban Transit Network, Inc. (“TransNet”), and Tri County Transit Service, Inc. (“Tri County”) (collectively, the “Joint Protestants”), by and through their attorneys, hereby submit this Prehearing Conference Memorandum in accordance with 52 Pa. Code § 5.222 of the regulations of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) and the Prehearing Conference Order of the Administrative Law Judge (“ALJ”) dated January 21, 2026.

I. INTRODUCTION AND BACKGROUND

On December 2, 2025, Guardian NEMT, LLC (“Guardian” or “Applicant”) filed an Application for Motor Common Carrier of Persons in Paratransit Service. The application was published in the Pennsylvania Bulletin as a request for the right to begin to provide paratransit

service generally from points in Montgomery County to points in Pennsylvania, and return (“Application”).

II. DATES OF AVAILABILITY FOR HEARING

Counsel for Protestants is available for a hearing on the following dates in April and May, 2026:

April 14, 15, 29, 30

May 12, 13, 19, 20, 21

III. WITNESSES

The Protestants intend to examine the witnesses presented by Applicant to demonstrate technical and financial fitness, including the sufficiency of capital, equipment, facilities and other resources to serve the territory requested, safely and adequately. Protestants reserve the right to call witnesses to address any issues that may be raised during the course of the proceeding and will identify such additional witnesses within a reasonable period of time prior to the commencement of the hearing.

VI. TIME FOR PRESENTATION OF CASE

Protestants do not anticipate requiring more than four hours for their portion of the case.

IX. DISCOVERY AND SETTLEMENT

Protestants intend to engage in discovery. Protestants are willing to engage in settlement discussions with the objective of achieving a mutually acceptable resolution of this matter, subject to the Commission's approval.
