Request for Information

1.) Question #10 of the application.

The Territory description is not acceptable. Please revise your request or verify that the below example is what you now intend. Please make corrections with the Commission's criteria in mind or verify that the example below is what you now intend. You cannot use ambiguous language such as "surrounding communities".

- The Public Utility Commission is specifically concerned with the location in which trips by your company will originate. Your requested territory must have boundaries and is typically requested by County / Counties.

Example:

To transport, as a common carrier, by motor vehicle, persons in Paratransit Service, from points in the Allegheny and Beaver Counties, to points in Pennsylvania, and return.

- This example is not limiting you to a vehicle type, activity regarding non-emergency medical transportation, or transportation for virtually any reason. You can leave Allegheny and Beaver Counties and return. This language would give your company the broadest customer base to work with.

2.) Question #5 of the Verified Statement.

Provide compliant policies that satisfy the requirements of 52 Pa Code with revision to the specific chapters below. Please review Title 52 information online, which may be

accessed at www.pacode.com.

A.) § 29.503. Age restrictions. Will drivers have to be at least a certain minimum age?

B.) Driver History. How often will a driver license check be done?

C.) § 29.505. Criminal history. How often will a record check be done and what are the disqualifications of employment?

3.) Question #6 of the Verified Statement.

A.) You stated 1 company vehicle here, yet you indicated nothing under the motor vehicle equipment section on the balance sheet. Please explain the discrepancy.

B.) In your original proposal under question #10 of the application you mentioned ambulatory and people in wheelchairs, how is this vehicle suitable for this specific service?

C.) Include a copy of the vehicle registration for each vehicle currently in the possession of King of Kings Non-Emergency Medical Transportation LLC.

D.) If there is no company ownership of a vehicle, please provide an explanation as to why you believe your company is equipped to provide transportation services.

4.) Question #7 of the Verified Statement.

Who will be conducting PA vehicle inspections? Explain your monthly maintenance, does this entail checking of brakes, lights, exhaust, oil etc. to ensure that all are functioning properly?

5.) Question #8 of the Verified Statement.

What are the amounts for the required commercial coverage that has been quoted to the applicant?

6.) Financial Position.

A.) The Balance Sheet was incomplete. Submit a complete balance sheet (no blank designations) and revise it, by removing personal property with an explanation of what has changed and why is required. Or provide proof of ownership of all claimed vehicles and land/buildings such as copies of titles/registrations in the name of King Transportation LLC. We need to know if the applicant is co-mingling

- member's assets/debts, which is not permissible.
- If you do choose to input a vehicle value which may benefit you, again include proof of ownership with a title and/or registration in the name of the applicant (King of Kings of Non-Emergency Medical Transportation LLC).
 - Please ensure that the figures provided are accurate as of the date provided on the balance sheet, and that all figures provided are based on the best available information.
 - Any assets which may need transferred to the applicant should happen prior to adding them to the balance sheet.

B.) At this point it is expected that the applicant's account is now filled and ready to commence operations with the ability to provide safe, efficient, and reliable service. Please provide supporting documentation for the balance sheet. Acceptable means of support include current copies of bank statements or notarized/official statements of account balances/ownership provided by bank officers (with current contact information) in the name of "King of Kings of Non-Emergency Medical Transportation LLC". (account numbers may be redacted)

Note: It is the responsibility of the applicant seeking motor common carrier authority to demonstrate that it possesses the financial ability to provide the proposed service. As per 52 Pa. Code §41.14, applications may be denied if the applicant fails to satisfy fitness standards. Be advised that additional corrections may not always be requested; therefore, prior to submitting your responses, your consultation with an attorney or financial expert familiar with Commission regulated Motor Carrier-related proceedings is highly encouraged.
