On January 5, 2026, the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission) received Clear Energy Solutions LLC's Application for a Natural Gas Supplier (NGS) license. On February 6, 2026, the Commission served a Deficiency Secretarial Letter requesting missing or incomplete information. On February 24, 2026, Clear Energy Solutions LLC filed responses to the Deficiency Secretarial Letter. In order for us to complete our analysis of Clear Energy Solutions LLC's NGS Application, the Commission's Energy Industry Group requires answers to the attached questions.


