On December 23, 2025, the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission) received Radiate Energy, LLC's Application for a Natural Gas Supplier (NGS) license. On February 4, 2026, the Commission served a Deficiency Secretarial Letter requesting missing or incomplete information. On February 20, 2026, Radiate Energy, LLC filed responses to the Deficiency Secretarial Letter. In order for us to complete our analysis of Radiate Energy, LLC's NGS Application, the Commission's Energy Industry Group requires answers to the attached questions.

Data Requests

1. Reference Application, Section 4.d – Proposed Service Area: The Applicant states that it is seeking licensure in all Natural Gas Distribution Company (NGDC) service territories. However, the Applicant did not provide a bonding letter for National Fuel Gas Distribution Corporation. Additionally, the bonding letters issued by UGI Utilities and PECO indicate that the Applicant is seeking licensure as a *broker/marketer*. The bonding letters should instead reference the Applicant as a “supplier” to align with the Applicant’s proposed operations in Pennsylvania.
2. Reference Application, Sections 6.a and 6.b – Certificate of Service: The Applicant is required to provide a Certificate of Service demonstrating proof of service. Please refer to Appendix C of the Application for the applicable requirements.
3. Reference Application, Section 12 – Notarized Proofs of Publication: The Applicant must provide notarized proofs of publication for each NGDC service territory in which it seeks licensure.
