INTERIM ORDER
CONFIRMING REQUIREMENTS FOR EVIDENTIARY HEARING

A telephone prehearing conference was convened on Friday, December 12, 2025, at 10:00 a.m. The Company, OCA, OSBA, I&E, CAUSE-PA participated and were represented by Counsel. Individual Complainant Joel Jackson also participated, without counsel.

At the Prehearing Conference, the Company's Consolidation Petition, requesting to consolidate the two R- dockets and all of the C-dockets identified above and subsequently filed and related to this proceeding under Docket No. R-2025-3057983, was granted.

On December 17, 2025, a Prehearing Order was entered adopting a litigation schedule in this proceeding.

On January 7, 2026, a Further Prehearing Conference was held whereby the Parties agreed to cancel the Public Input Hearings scheduled for January 29, 2026, at 1 and 6 p.m. in New Garden Township, and to reschedule those hearings for the same date and time at the Coatesville City Hall and to further modify the litigation schedule.

On January 26, 2026, an In-Person Evidentiary Hearing Notice was issued scheduling the evidentiary hearing for March 23, 2026, through March 25, 2026, in Harrisburg, Pennsylvania.

On January 28, 2026, an Interim Order was entered approving modifications to the litigation schedule, as follows:

On February 18, 2026, counsel for OCA advised the undersigned presiding officers and the active parties that one of OCA's witnesses, Roger Colton, would be out of the country between the dates Rebuttal testimony is due and Surrebuttal Testimony is due. Counsel

for OCA requested that the deadline for Mr. Colton's Surrebuttal testimony be moved from Friday, March 13, 2026, to Monday, March 16, 2026, at noon. Counsel for OCA advised that the Company agreed to this modification and that no party opposed the request from OCA.

On March 2, 2026, an Interim Order was entered modifying the modified litigation schedule approved by Interim Order entered on January 28, 2026, to extend the deadline for OCA witness Roger Colton to submit surrebuttal testimony from Friday, March 13, 2026, to Monday, March 16, 2026, at noon. The parties were further directed to comply in all other respects with the Interim Order entered on January 28, 2026.

The In-Person Evidentiary Hearing has been scheduled for March 23, 2026, through March 25, 2026, in Harrisburg, Pennsylvania.

The Office of Administrative Law Judge has received a number of inquiries from various individuals and entities, who are not necessarily active parties, regarding how evidence and exhibits are to be offered into evidence at the evidentiary hearing in this proceeding. These individuals and entities are encouraged to review the Prehearing Orders issued in this proceeding, as well as the applicable provisions of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Code and the Commission regulations regarding inquiries related to the control of evidentiary hearings and the admission of evidence by the presiding officers at evidentiary hearings in rate proceedings before the Commission.

In addition, in order to assist the active parties and other interested individuals in the preparation for the evidentiary hearing, the following Interim Order will be entered.

THEREFORE,

IT IS ORDERED:

1. That only active parties shall be afforded an opportunity to present evidence at an evidentiary hearing.

2. That, in order to be considered an active party, an individual or entity must (1) file a complaint pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 5.21 et seq. or a petition to intervene pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 5.71 et seq., and (2) if filing a complaint under 52 Pa. Code § 5.21, 52 Pa. Code § 5.22, or 52 Pa. Code § 5.32, file also correspondence with the Commission's Secretary's Bureau indicating an intent to participate as an active party, as directed in the Prehearing Order entered December 17, 2025, and (3) comply with the provisions set forth in the Prehearing Order entered December 17, 2025 as amended.

3. The active parties as well as any individual or entity desiring to participate in these proceedings shall comply with the terms of all Orders issued in this proceeding, including the Prehearing Order entered on December 17, 2025, and amended by Interim Orders entered on January 28, 2026, and March 2, 2026.

4. For any evidentiary hearings conducted in this proceeding, either in-person or telephonically, evidentiary hearing exhibits admitted into evidence, including written testimony and exhibits, shall be sent to the court reporter electronically by the party sponsoring the exhibits by the close of business on the last day of hearings, with an electronic copy provided to the presiding officers. This provision serves the interests of the environment and saving ratepayers money from the expenditure of printing voluminous hard copies.

5. In the event that all active parties have stipulated to waive cross-examination and to excuse a witness from attending the evidentiary hearing, if one is held, and if such stipulation has been approved by the presiding officers, the sponsoring active party need not include the witness's pre-served testimony and exhibits as part of the active party's evidentiary hearing exhibits, as long as the pre-served testimony has already been circulated to the presiding officers and all other active parties in this proceeding. In such event, the pre-served testimony of such witnesses, whose appearance and cross-examination have been waived, may be identified for movement into the record at the evidentiary hearing through an inventory of pre-served testimony which must be provided by the sponsoring active party as a hearing exhibit. In such case, the evidentiary hearing exhibits, including written testimony and exhibits admitted into

evidence, shall be sent to the court reporter electronically by the active party sponsoring the exhibits by the close of business on the last day of hearings, with a copy provided electronically to the presiding officers.

6. If an in-person evidentiary hearing is convened, and witnesses appear at the evidentiary hearing to provide oral rejoinder testimony or be subject to cross-examination, copies of all written testimony of such witness, as well as all accompanying exhibits, will be provided to the witness who prepared each written testimony, the presiding officers, the court reporter, and all other active parties at the evidentiary hearing. However, the active parties may agree to waive circulation of pre-served written testimony at the evidentiary hearing, among themselves, as the active parties agree.

7. In the event an evidentiary hearing is conducted telephonically, evidentiary hearing exhibits need not include all pre-served testimony which has previously been circulated to the presiding officers and active parties in this proceeding in accordance with the above-referenced procedural schedule. However, in the alternative, such pre-served testimony may be identified for movement into the record at the hearing through an inventory of pre-served testimony which must be provided as a hearing exhibit by the active party sponsoring the witness. In such case, the evidentiary hearing exhibits, including written testimony and exhibits admitted into evidence, as well as the inventory of pre-served testimony provided as a hearing exhibit, shall be sent to the court reporter electronically by the active party sponsoring the exhibits by the close of business on the last day of hearings, with a copy provided to the presiding officers.

8. All stipulations entered by the active parties must be reduced to writing, signed by the active parties to be bound thereby, and moved into the record for consideration by the presiding officers, during the hearing in this case, if one is held. An exception to this requirement may occur when circumstances of time and expediency warrant. In such case, an oral presentation of a stipulation is permissible, if it is followed by a reduction to writing as herein directed. In the event an evidentiary hearing is not held, stipulations must be reduced to writing, signed by the active parties to be bound thereby, and filed with the Commission's

Secretary's Bureau, along with an appropriate motion, and served on the presiding officers and all active parties.

9. That all active parties who intend to present evidence of any kind or to examine any witnesses shall promptly consult with all other active parties and identify and exchange a list of all witnesses, and copies of all written testimonies, exhibits, any other evidence, and all such documents and materials that each such active party intends to introduce into evidence at the evidentiary hearing as well as a list of all testimony, documents, materials and evidence of any kind, that each active party intends to use or offer into evidence at the evidentiary hearing, not later than Wednesday, March 18, 2026, at 12:00 noon. In addition, a master list of all such written testimonies, exhibits, and all such documents and materials, including verifications or affidavits of witnesses, to be offered by all active parties, individuals or entities shall also be provided to the undersigned presiding officers not later than **Thursday, March 19, 2026, at 10:00 a.m.**

10. That all active parties who intend to present evidence or examine witnesses at the evidentiary hearing, if one is held, shall promptly consult with each other and with all of the other active parties and prepare a witness matrix, which shall include the identification of all proposed witnesses and indicate which active parties intend to cross-examine the witnesses and the approximate amount of time for examination of each witness by each active party and cross-examination by each active party. The witness matrix shall be provided to the undersigned presiding officers not later than **Thursday, March 19, 2026, at 12:00 noon.**

11. That no written testimony will be admitted into evidence at the evidentiary hearings unless accompanied by a verification or affidavit of the witness.

12. That no other oral or written testimony, exhibits, or evidence of any kind will be admitted into evidence at the evidentiary hearings unless the active party sponsoring such evidence has fully and timely complied with the terms and provisions set forth in this Interim Order and has provided all other active parties and the presiding officers with a written

summary of any oral direct testimony and a copy of any written testimony, exhibits, or evidence of any kind, not later than **Friday March 13, 2026 at 4:00 p.m.**

13. In the event of a full settlement by the active parties, a request to cancel the evidentiary hearings will be considered only if the settling parties file a fully executed joint stipulation for the admission of evidence with the Secretary's Bureau not later than **Thursday, March 19, 2026, at 4:00 PM**. The stipulation must include: (1) a stipulation that all active parties waive cross-examination of all witnesses, (2) a list of all testimonies and exhibits to be admitted into the record, either embedded within the stipulation or attached to the stipulation, (3) a stipulation that the testimonies and exhibits to be admitted into the record are admissible and should be admitted. If such a stipulation is filed, the presiding officers may issue an Order adopting the stipulation, admitting the evidence into the record, cancelling the evidentiary hearings, and ordering the active parties to file their testimonies and exhibits, with appropriate verifications, with the Commission's Secretary's Bureau along with a copy of the Order. The stipulation shall also be provided to the presiding officers in *Microsoft Office Word* format.

14. Confidential Security Information (CSI) as defined by 35 P.S. § 2141 *et seq.* should not be transmitted by email or other electronic means. The parties are to avoid introducing CSI into the record and should develop alternative means, such as joint stipulations or redaction when proposing testimony or exhibits. If there is no other alternative to establishing a material fact other than by CSI, the parties are to contact the Administrative Law Judges immediately and in advance of the evidentiary hearing to address the use of CSI.

15. That all parties shall comply in all respects with the terms of all Interim Orders entered in this proceeding, not inconsistent with the terms set forth in this Interim Order.
