On February 27, 2026, the Commission received your February 24, 2026 Letter in which you requested waiver of regulatory advertising requirements (Waiver Request). You filed the Waiver Request at Docket No. A-2026-3059622.

Please note that 52 Pa. Code §§ 5.41 and 5.43 set forth the requirements for petitions seeking waiver of Commission regulations. The Waiver Request you submitted does not conform to the requirements set forth in the Commission's regulations. See 52 Pa. Code §§ 5.41, 5.43.

Accordingly, your Waiver Request is rejected for failure to comply with the law and the Commission's regulations. See 52 Pa. Code §§ 1.38, 5.41, 5.43.

Notwithstanding the above rejection of your Waiver Request, you may file a new petition for waiver of regulatory requirements with the Commission. If you elect to file a new petition, kindly ensure it conforms with the requirements set forth in 52 Pa. Code §§ 5.41, 5.43. Please note that Section 5.43 also requires you as petitioner to properly serve your petition on certain parties. 52 Pa. Code § 5.43. Failure to properly serve your petition on the parties identified in Section 5.43 may result in the petition being rejected again. 52 Pa. Code § 1.38.
