I am writing to you in my capacity as Chairman of the Pennsylvania House Consumer Protection, Technology and Utilities Committee regarding the recent decision rendered by the Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) on the proposed extension of bi-directional service on the Laurel Pipeline, under Public Utility Commission Docket No. C-2025-3053018, concerning Monroe Energy, LLC, Lucknow-Highspire Terminals, LLC, Sheetz, Inc., and PBF Holding Company LLC v. Laurel Pipeline Company, LLC.

Given the significant implications this matter holds for local communities and Pennsylvania ratepayers, I respectfully urge the Commission to undertake a comprehensive and careful review of the ALJ's decision before proceeding. The extension of bi-directional service on the Laurel Pipeline presents complex considerations that warrant rigorous scrutiny from both regulatory and community perspectives.
