To Whom It May Concern:

The purpose of this Letter is to advise you that your Application, Docket No. A-2026-3060796 has been **DENIED** by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission). The Commission has determined that a Certificate of Public Convenience **WILL NOT BE GRANTED** for the following reason(s):

• Failure to establish fitness to operate:

On March 2, 2026, the application of GMT Transportation, LLC, was accepted by the Commission for review. In analyzing the applicant's application and supporting statements multiple deficiencies were noted. On March 6, 2026, the applicant was issued a 10-day data request seeking necessary policy revisions and suitable evidence to establish its ability to offer safe, efficient, and reasonable transportation. The applicant was provided with detailed guidance and examples to assist it in providing the necessary corrections and updates.

The applicant's response to the Commission was received on March 6, 2026, approximately three hours after the Commission's request. The applicant's response included a notation which stated, "[t]his filing is submitted to replace the previously submitted version and ensure the application is complete and accurate;" however the application remains incomplete. The only update to the previous filing noted by the applicant was updates to vehicle identification information. The applicant's response failed to address numerous policy deficiencies which were explained in the Commission's data request, and it also lacked the requested evidence of financial fitness. Absent the requested updates and evidence, the Commission is unable to make a reasoned determination of the applicant's fitness to operate.

For these reasons the application is DISMISSED and DENIED

APPEAL RIGHTS

ALL Parties to proceedings pending before the Commission must open and use an e-filing account through the Commission's website, OR you may submit your filing by overnight delivery. If a filing contains confidential or proprietary material, the filing is required to be submitted by overnight delivery.

If you disagree with this determination, you may send a Petition for Reconsideration of Staff Action to: Secretary, Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission, 400 North Street, Harrisburg, PA 17120. Such a Petition is a written statement asking the Commission to change its determination.

The Petition must be filed with the Commission within twenty (20) days of the date of this letter. If no timely request for reconsideration is made, this action will be deemed to be the final action of the Commission.

The Petition MUST include: (1) a written statement (divided into numbered paragraphs) outlining the reasons for the request, (2) the case docket number(s) (they are provided for you at the top right hand corner of this letter), (3) the name of the person on whose behalf the petition is made, (4) copies of relevant documentation, and (5) a verification with original signature. See 52 Pa. Code §§-1.31 and 5.44.
