Request for Information

- 1.) Under question number 4 of the Verified Statement of Applicant, your response was that your business will be located at 106 N State Road, Upper Darby PA 19082 and it appears to be a residential address.
  - a. What are the plans for storing a shipper's goods if the move cannot be completed in one day? Do you have a storage unit? If not, how will you ensure that the vehicle containing household goods will be safe from theft while parked at a residential address?
  
- 2.) Under question number 5 of the Verified Statement of Applicant, you mention one driver however there is no mention of staff or another person to assist you with household goods moves.
  - a. Will you hire an employee to assist you with household goods moves? If not, how will larger objects be moved?
  
  - b. How often will driver's license checks be conducted as required by 52 Pa. Code §37.204 49 CFR §391.25 – Driver history (schedule and retention) and how long will these records be retained?
  
  - c. How often will criminal background checks be conducted as required by 52 Pa. Code §31.134 49 CFR §382.301 – Criminal history (schedule and retention) and how long will these records be maintained?
  
  - d. How often will drug and alcohol testing be conducted as required by 52 Pa. Code §37.204 and how long will these records be maintained 49 CFR §382.401? Please provide a copy of your policy regarding drug and alcohol testing.

- 3.) Question 6 of the Verified Statement of Applicant asks you to provide your vehicle information.
  - a. Do you intend to purchase or rent a vehicle for household goods moves?
  - b. Should you rent a vehicle (U-Haul or similar), will your insurance company provide proof of commercial liability insurance (Form E) and commercial cargo insurance (Form H) for that rental?
- 4.) Question 7 of the Verified Statement of Applicant requests information regarding vehicle maintenance.
  - a. Please provide a copy of your policy and/ or checklist for ensuring your vehicle will comply with applicable equipment standards (67 Pa. Code, Chapter 175).
- 5.) The Statement of Financial Fitness (Balance Sheet) should only contain information for Legistics LLC and not your personal account.
  - a. There is \$500.00 listed as a property asset. Please explain the \$500 for property. Only property titled or registered to Legistics LLC should be included on the balance sheet.
  - b. Please provide a bank statement for Legistics LLC. The assets/ cash you provided on your balance sheet (\$2,000) will not be enough to meet the finances required to conduct Household Goods moves. The costs needed for a vehicle and commercial insurance will exceed that amount. Should you not have funded an account for Legistics LLC, now is the time do so.

**Failure to provide answers to all of the questions is sufficient grounds for the denial of your application so please get assistance or you may hire an attorney to aid you in the application process.**
