Dear Judge Gannon –

Thank you for the granting of an extension of time to be able to reply to the new matter brought up by First Energy. I am filing my answer and reply per the orders directed in your communication on February 20, 2026.

It is important to note that the opposing council did not object to granting a 15-day extension [see below] from their standpoint putting the due date to reply by or on February 24, 2026 using the date of February 9, 2026 when I filed the petition for extension. The letter date referenced above (2.20.26) states that I had missed the deadline to reply which is not the case in this situation to my knowledge. I am not sure what happened to my e-file and letter requesting the extension as I never heard anything back from anyone at the PA PUC until the notification that you were being assigned to the case on February 19, 2026.

In regard to the subject at hand of filing an answer and reply to the new matter, I deny the claim raised in its entirety of the new claim against me levied by First Energy. To the contrary, it is just the same as I raised it in my complaint.

I would encourage that the customer service records to include recordings of my account at First Energy be subpoenaed to illustrate that I made several attempts alerting the utility company of the correct meter # (Unit A) that was associated with my account was not correct and they chose to do nothing about it and ignore my plea to get it corrected.

First Energy acted carelessly and displayed gross negligence and incompetence in the handling of this matter. Furthermore, the lack of responsibility, awareness, action, and accountability by their organization clearly demonstrates their inability to take ownership or responsibility for the series of mistakes made in handling the situation.

Lastly, further evidence has surfaced recently on how poorly this was managed by First Energy that strengthens my case against the organization.

On your 3<sup>rd</sup> order outlined encouraging parties discuss a resolution, I am certainly open to having these discussions with First Energy representation to come to a reasonable settlement and solution. I encourage Ms. Morris to reach out so we can work together in the spirit of striking a resolution to this matter.


I look forward to a response and learning of the next steps in the process if a suitable resolution cannot be reached in the interim.
