

Application for Motor Common Carrier of Persons in Limousine Service

This application is required to operate as a common carrier of persons in luxury vehicles seating no more than 10 when providing transportation between points in Pennsylvania. Applicants providing service between points in the city and county of Philadelphia or from any airport, railroad station or hotel located in whole or in part in Philadelphia, must apply to the Philadelphia Parking Authority. I also have extensive knowledge and hands on experience at my fathers machine shop and with his goodyear tire and auto repair shop dealership in Louisiana.

All drivers will be equipped with cellular phones and company will use tracking software to monitor trips. Camera will be installed to monitor trips for safety of passengers and driver.

Our drivers are all professional and uniformed personnel whose background checks are clear through FCRA background checks. Drivers will be required to review and pass video modules and most will already have a commercial drivers license. Drivers license check will be conducted as required, in addition our software will notify us of dates of renewal and any restrictions imposed. Drug and alcohol use will be zero tolerance without exception, as a certified alcohol awareness trainer I Joseph Bulot will observe and report before and after each trip.

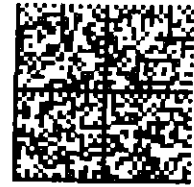
