To Whom It May Concern,

On December 31, 2025, the Commission received Superior VIP Limousine's LLC's request to cancel a certificate of public convenience. However, Superior VIP Limousine's LLC still owes its outstanding assessment in the amount of \$223.00.

Section 510 of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. § 510, authorizes the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission to assess all public utilities a percentage of their gross intrastate operating revenues for the preceding calendar year. The Commission sent Superior VIP Limousine's LLC Notice of Assessment for fiscal year 2025/2026 on or around December 3, 2025.

The Notice of Assessment advised Superior VIP Limousine's LLC that it had thirty (30) days to pay the amount assessed. Superior VIP Limousine's LLC was further advised that if it had any objections to the assessed amount that objections had to be made in writing within fifteen (15) days and submit payment for the assessed amount.

Superior VIP Limousine's LLC did not file objections to the assessed amount and it has not submitted payment for the assessed amount.

The Commission will cancel Superior VIP Limousine's LLC's certificate of public convenience within twenty (20) days of the date of this letter. Furthermore, if Superior VIP Limousine's LLC's outstanding assessment is not paid within twenty (20) days of this letter, the Commission will refer this matter to the Attorney General of Pennsylvania for appropriate action and request suspension or revocation of automobile registration with the Department of Transportation.
