Dear Secretary's Bureau:

This firm represents Non Profit Emergency Service of Beaver County, Inc. t/d/b/a Medic Rescue, which is applying for amended paratransit authority at Docket No. A-2025-3059091. It is our understanding that the amended authority at Docket No. A-2025-3059091 can only be issued if Medic Rescue discontinues its Certificate of Public Convenience issued at Docket No. A-00114249. For this reason alone and contingent upon the Commission's issuance of the Certificate of Public Convenience at Docket No. A-2025-3059091 in such a manner that Medic Rescue does not have a lapse in or absence of paratransit authority, files the attached "Application for Approval of Abandonment or Discontinuance of Service, In Whole Or In Part," for Non Profit Emergency Service of Beaver County, Inc. t/d/b/a Medic Rescue's authority at Docket No. A-00114249, which is what we understand needs to be filed in order for the PUC to issue Medic Rescue a Certificate of Convenience for its expanded authority. To be clear, this filing is only for a discontinuance in part, and is only for a discontinuance of the paratransit authority the PUC originally issued to Medic Rescue back in 1998!


4. This application is for the discontinuance of part, paratransit


