Dear Parties:

On February 17, 2026, the Commission entered an Initial Decision in the above-referenced matter. By way of a Secretarial Letter, the parties were served the Initial Decision on the same date. The Secretarial Letter advised the parties that they had 20 days from the date of the Secretarial Letter, until March 9, 2026, in which to file exceptions to the Initial Decision. The SEC Letter also included directions regarding how to file exceptions to the Initial Decision. As of the date of this letter, no exceptions have been filed.

On March 10, 2026, it came to my attention that the caption on the February 17, 2026, Secretarial Letter contained a typographical error in that the Complainant was inadvertently misidentified. The respondent's name and the docket number were correctly identified. The caption on the Initial Decision also correctly identified the Complainant. Complainant was properly served the initial decision and the February 17, 2026, Secretarial Letter via eService.¹

In order to correct the typographical error on the February 17, 2026 Secretarial Letter so it properly identifies the Complainant, and to ensure due process and an opportunity to have her exceptions, if any, considered by the Commission, under cover of this Secretarial Letter, the Commission is hereby re-serving the Initial Decision on the parties.

The parties will have until March 20, 2026, (10 days from the date of this Secretarial Letter) to file exceptions to the February 17, 2026, Initial Decision. Thereafter, any party may file reply exceptions on or before March 27, 2026.
