**INTERIM ORDER**  
**REOPENING RECORD, ATTACHING COMPLAINANT’S OBJECTION**  
**TO RECORD, AND DIRECTING A CONFERENCE BE HELD**

An evidentiary hearing was held on February 13, 2025. Both Complainant and counsel for the Company were present. During the hearing, I directed Respondent to submit a late-filed exhibit, FE PA Ex. 15. Tr. 144. I gave Complainant until March 6, 2025, to file any objection to the admission of FE PA Ex. 15. *Id.*

On February 20, 2025, the Company emailed FE PA Ex. 15 to me and Complainant.

On March 4, 2026, Complainant sent me an objection via First-Class Mail but did not file it with the Commission’s Secretary’s Bureau. Further, there is no indication that he also served this objection on the Company. In his objection, Complainant argues that FE PA does not pertain to his property.

On October 22, 2025, I issued an Interim Order attaching FE PA’s Exhibit to the record, erroneously noting that Complainant had not filed an objection, and closing the record.

Due to administrative oversight, Complainant’s objection has not been attached to the record nor has the *ex parte* nature of it been cured. Therefore, Complainant’s objection is attached to this Order.

Due to Complainant's objection to the admission of FE PA Ex. 15, it is appropriate to convene a conference to discuss the admissibility and relevance of FE PA Ex. 15.

THEREFORE,

IT IS ORDERED:

1. That this matter is re-opened.
2. That Ordering Paragraph 1 of the Interim Order dated October 22, 2025, is rescinded such that FE PA Ex. 1 is not considered part of the evidentiary record.
3. That the parties appear at a conference to be scheduled to address the relevance and admissibility of FE PA 15.

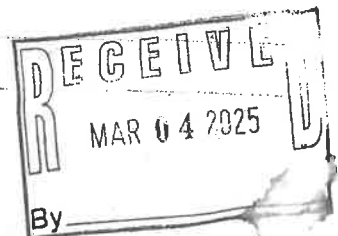
