3. Give a general description of the nature and character of the services rendered by the applicant.

CBTS-TS is authorized to provide competitive local exchange services and resold interexchange services pursuant to authority granted in Docket Nos. A-311306, A-2009-2125861, & A-2009-2125864. The certificates were originally granted to Cincinnati Bell Any Distance Inc. CBTS-TS

informed the PUC of the name change in Docket No. R-2017-2635538 and certificates reflecting the new name were issued via Secretarial Letter.

4. Provide a statement of change in service proposed by the company for which Commission approval is sought.

CBTS-TS is seeking to surrender its authority to operate in Pennsylvania as it no longer provides competitive local exchange services and resold interexchange services in the state. CBTS-TS no longer has customers receiving competitive local exchange services and resold interexchange services in Pennsylvania and so no discontinuance notice is required.

5. Provide a summary of the revenue derived from the operation of the service sought to be discontinued, together with a statement of the expenses accruing from the maintenance of that service. This information may be furnished in detail and attached to the application.

The Pennsylvania revenue derived from operation of the competitive local exchange services and resold interexchange services is provided in CONFIDENTIAL Exhibit A.

6. Approval of the application is necessary or proper for the following reasons:

CBTS-TS submits that the public interest will not be harmed by the surrender because the company no longer has customers receiving competitive local exchange services and resold interexchange services.

7. Provide a detailed explanation of why the company wishes to abandon its Certificate.

CBTS-TS no longer provides competitive local exchange services and resold interexchange services.

8. Provide the number of customers served and date last served.

CBTS-TS no longer has competitive local exchange services and resold interexchange services customers. Customers ceased receiving such services in December 2025.

9. What happened to these customers? Who is serving them now?

These customers have been transitioned to Voice over Internet Protocol Services ("VoIP"). CBTS-TS is separately filing a letter regarding its provision of VoIP services in Pennsylvania.

10. Are there any NXX Codes assigned to your company? If yes, how many?

No.

11. How are the NXX Codes affected by this abandonment?

Not applicable.

12. Has the company contacted NANPA regarding returning the NXX Codes?

Not applicable.

13. Has the company contacted the appropriate municipal/city authority of the abandonment for 911 purposes?

CBTS has not contacted the municipal/city authority for abandonment of 911 because it does not provide 911 directly (flows through another carrier) and has no customers.

WHEREFORE, for the reasons set forth above, Applicant requests the Commission grant all authority necessary to surrender the Certificates.
