RATIFICATION ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On February 19, 2026, Chairman Stephen M. DeFrank issued an Emergency Temporary Authorization Order (ETA Order) in response to the Ex Parte Petition for Emergency Relief (Petition) filed by UGI Utilities, Inc. – Gas Division (UGI Gas or Company) on February 17, 2026, with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission). The Petition seeks permission from the Commission to temporarily reduce the Company’s Purchased Gas Adjustment (PGC) Quarterly Adjustment Mechanism (QAM) rate change cap from 25% to 10% for the March 1, 2026 quarterly C- factor adjustment. UGI asserts that the Commission granting the request sought in the Petition will help avoid clear and present dangers to life and property by enabling

customers, including non-low-income customers, to reduce affordability challenges that could limit access to essential natural gas heating service.


Upon review of the circumstances surrounding the issuance of the ex parte Emergency Order, we conclude that it is in the public interest to make such action the action of the full Commission; **THEREFORE,**

IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the ex parte Emergency Order issued February 19, 2026, at Docket No. P-2026-3060521, is hereby ratified.

2. That a copy of this Ratification Order be served upon all parties served with the ex parte Emergency Order issued February 19, 2026.
