The applicant will manage the operations of NUREX LLC. Although the applicant does not have prior direct experience operating a transportation company, he has completed relevant orientation and training and has studied Pennsylvania PUC requirements for non-emergency medical transportation services

NUREX LLC operates from its business address at 743 Hopkins Ave, Bensalem, PA 19020, which serves as the administrative office for scheduling, dispatch, and record keeping. Standard office equipment including computers, telephone, and internet will be used for business operations. Vehicles used for transportation will be parked at the business location or other approved locations when not in service.

Business and operational records required by the Pennsylvania PUC, including trip records, driver information, insurance documentation, and vehicle records, will be maintained electronically and in secure files at the business office.

Customer transportation requests will be received by phone, email, or through medical transportation brokers. Trips will be scheduled and dispatched using phone communication and electronic scheduling tools. Drivers will maintain communication with dispatch through mobile phones to ensure efficient service and coordination.

Initially, the company plans to operate with 1–3 drivers, depending on service demand within the Bucks County service area.

B. Criminal background checks

All drivers will undergo criminal background checks in accordance with applicable Pennsylvania requirements.

C. Driver training program

Drivers will receive training related to passenger safety, customer service, non-emergency medical transportation procedures, and safe vehicle operation.

D. Driver license checks

Driver licenses and driving records will be verified before hiring and monitored periodically.

E. Alcohol and drug policy (NUREX LLC maintains a strict zero-tolerance policy regarding alcohol or drug use by drivers while on duty)

NUREX LLC plans to initially operate with 1–2 vehicles suitable for non-emergency medical transportation of ambulatory and wheelchair passengers. This number of vehicles is appropriate for the initial service demand within Bucks County and surrounding areas. Additional vehicles will be added as service demand increases. Vehicles will meet all Pennsylvania PUC safety, insurance, and operational requirements.

NUREX LLC will maintain a vehicle safety program to ensure that all vehicles are safe and reliable for passenger transportation. Vehicles will undergo regular inspections and preventative maintenance according to manufacturer recommendations. Drivers will conduct routine pre-trip and post-trip inspections to identify any safety issues.

All vehicles used in service will comply with applicable Pennsylvania vehicle equipment and safety standards, including the requirements of 67 Pa. Code, Chapter 175. Any mechanical issues will be repaired promptly before the vehicle is returned to service.

The applicant has contacted insurance providers and obtained quotes for the insurance coverage required for non-emergency medical transportation operations in Pennsylvania.
