

3. The District has sought active party status in this matter in order to represent the interests of a public school district that receives water and/or wastewater service from Pennsylvania-American Water Company.

4. The District respectfully requests permission for its representative and counsel to attend and participate in the March 23-25, 2026 evidentiary hearing via telephone.

5. All active parties that are municipal or government entities are required to be represented by legal counsel which is an additional financial burden on the Intervenor public school district.

6. Telephonic participation will allow the District to monitor the proceedings, participate as appropriate, and protect its interests while minimizing travel time and expense associated with attendance in Harrisburg.

7. The District does not anticipate that telephonic participation will prejudice any party or disrupt the orderly conduct of the hearing.

8. The District would be unduly burdened by requiring the Chief Business Officer to be out of District for three consecutive days along with the excess burden expense incurred from legal counsel's presence at the hearing for three full days.

9. The District will comply with all technical requirements and instructions provided by the Commission or the assigned Administrative Law Judge for telephonic participation.

10. Good cause exists to grant this request because telephonic participation will facilitate efficient participation in the proceeding while reducing unnecessary travel and associated costs for a public educational institution.

11. Granting this motion will not delay the proceedings or prejudice any other party.

WHEREFORE, the Exeter Township School District respectfully requests that the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission grant this Motion and permit its representative and/or counsel to attend and participate in the March 23-25, 2026 evidentiary hearing via telephone.
