The Bureau of Audits has reviewed FirstEnergy Pennsylvania Electric Company's proposed Supplement No. 34 to Tariff Electric – Pa. P.U.C. No. 1 and the supporting rate computations submitted on February 27, 2026, and revised on March 5, 2026, to become effective on April 1, 2026.

Based upon staff review, it appears that the proposed LED Conversion Charge (LEDC) rates for the twelve-month period of April 1, 2026 through March 31, 2027 are consistent with the tariff and, accordingly, are permitted to become effective as filed.

The LEDC is subject to continuous Commission review and audit as well as reconciliation reports in accordance with Section 1307(e) of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. § 1307(e).

Pursuant to the Commission's regulations at 52 Pa. Code § 5.44 (relating to petitions for reconsideration from actions of the staff), you may appeal by filing a petition for reconsideration with the Commission within 20 days of the date of this letter.
