To Whom It May Concern:

The purpose of this Letter is to advise you that your Application, Docket No. A-2026-3061020 has been **DENIED** by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission). The Commission has determined that a Certificate of Public Convenience **WILL NOT BE GRANTED** for the following reason(s):

• **Failure to establish fitness to operate:**

On March 11, 2026, the applicant submitted an application requesting authority, “to transport house[h]old goods in use between interstate.” The interstate transportation of household goods in use lies outside of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission’s jurisdiction. As such, no authority can be granted by this Commission for those rights.

As an advisory note, had the applicant been seeking intrastate operation rights, the present application would have been denied for failure to provide the Commission with the bare minimum amount of information for the Commission to determine it’s fitness to provide safe, efficient, and reasonable transportation. In its application, the applicant failed to provide responses to eight of the 10 information requests featured in the verified statements for applicants, and provided only a partial response to one of the other inquiries. Additionally, no information was provided in reference to the requirements of 52 Pa. Code §3.381(c)(1)(iii)(A)(II)(-1-), which would serve as a block to unqualified applicants. Finally, the applicant’s balance sheet indicated only \$1 in current assets, which indicates a severe lack of financial fitness.

For these reasons the application is DISMISSED and DENIED

APPEAL RIGHTS

ALL Parties to proceedings pending before the Commission must open and use an e-filing account through the Commission's website, OR you may submit your filing by overnight delivery. If a filing contains confidential or proprietary material, the filing is required to be submitted by overnight delivery.

If you disagree with this determination, you may send a Petition for Reconsideration of Staff Action to: Secretary, Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission, 400 North Street, Harrisburg, PA 17120. Such a Petition is a written statement asking the Commission to change its determination.

The Petition must be filed with the Commission within twenty (20) days of the date of this letter. If no timely request for reconsideration is made, this action will be deemed to be the final action of the Commission.

The Petition MUST include: (1) a written statement (divided into numbered paragraphs) outlining the reasons for the request, (2) the case docket number(s) (they are provided for you at the top right hand corner of this letter), (3) the name of the person on whose behalf the petition is made, (4) copies of relevant documentation, and (5) a verification with original signature. See 52 Pa. Code §§-1.31 and 5.44.


