TO THE HONORABLE PENNSYLVANIA PUBLIC UTILITY COMMISSION:

Pursuant to 52 Pa. Code Sections 5.71 through 5.74, Walmart Inc. ("Walmart") hereby files this Petition to Intervene in the above-captioned proceeding. In support thereof, Walmart states as follows:

3. On February 3, 2026, FirstEnergy Pennsylvania Electric Company ("FE PA" or "Company") filed with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission ("PUC" or "Commission") its Petition for Approval of Its Default Service Program for the Period June 1, 2027, to May 31, 2031 ("DSP VII Petition").

4. Walmart has the privilege of providing its retail services in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania through its 116 Supercenters, 19 Discount Stores, 24 Sam's Clubs, and 11 Supply Chain Facilities.¹ Walmart is also a retail customer of FE PA, with 83 retail units, 5 distribution centers, and related facilities served by the Company. Walmart purchases more than 295.5 million kWh annually from FE PA's operating entities, primarily pursuant to Rate Schedule General Service-Large Demand (GSLD). The cost of electricity comprises a significant portion of the operating costs of Walmart's various retail and distribution locations.

5. Walmart is still in the process of evaluating whether it will sponsor testimony in this proceeding. In the event Walmart decides to sponsor testimony, Walmart will likely submit testimony from Steve W. Chriss, Senior Director, Utility Partnerships, and will promptly inform the parties and the presiding Administrative Law Judges ("ALJs") if this changes. Regardless, if intervention is granted, Walmart reserves the right to participate in this proceeding and adduce evidence through the submission of discovery, cross-examination of other parties' witnesses, and the submission of briefs, exceptions, and reply exceptions, as necessary.

6. The Commission's final determination in this proceeding may directly impact the terms and conditions of the electric service that Walmart receives from the Company at multiple locations. Walmart therefore has a direct, substantial, and unique interest in the outcome of this proceeding that is not represented by any other party. See 52 Pa. Code § 5.72(a)(2).
