**PREHEARING CONFERENCE MEMORANDUM OF
WALMART INC.**

Pursuant to the Prehearing Conference Order issued on February 19, 2026, by Deputy Chief Administrative Law Judge ("ALJ") Mark A. Hoyer and ALJ Erin L. Gannon, Walmart Inc. ("Walmart") hereby submits this Prehearing Conference Memorandum in the above-captioned proceeding.

I. HISTORY OF THE PROCEEDING

On February 3, 2026, FirstEnergy Pennsylvania Electric Company ("FE PA" or "Company") filed with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission ("PUC" or "Commission") its Petition for Approval of Its Default Service Program for the Period June 1, 2027, to May 31, 2031 ("DSP VII Petition").

III. ANTICIPATED ISSUES

Walmart is still evaluating FE PA's DSP VII Petition and anticipates being informed by the record created in this case. At this preliminary stage, however, Walmart plans to pay careful attention to FE PA's proposed criteria for determining if a non-residential default service customer is served under FE PA's Price to Compare Default Service Rate Rider or Hourly Pricing Default Service Rate Rider. Walmart anticipates pursuing this issue during this proceeding and reserves the right to raise further issues and to respond to all matters raised by other parties.

IV. PROPOSED WITNESSES AND EVIDENCE

Walmart is still in the process of evaluating whether it will sponsor testimony in this proceeding. In the event Walmart decides to sponsor testimony, Walmart will likely submit testimony from Steve W. Chriss, Senior Director, Utility Partnerships, and will promptly inform the parties and the ALJs if this changes. Regardless, Walmart reserves the right to participate in this proceeding and adduce evidence through the submission of discovery, cross-examination of other parties' witnesses, and the submission of briefs, exceptions, and reply exceptions, if necessary.

V. PROPOSED SCHEDULE AND DISCOVERY RULES


