    - i. How will background checks be conducted?
    - ii. How often will you conduct criminal background checks?

## **1. Driver Regulations (52 Pa Code §29.501–509)**

### **a. Hiring Standards for Drivers (52 Pa Code §29.503 – Age Restrictions)**

Star Medical Transportation Company will maintain strict hiring standards to ensure the safety and reliability of its transportation services.

#### **i. Age Restrictions:**

All drivers must be at least 21 years of age and possess a valid driver’s license issued by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania or another U.S. state. Drivers must also demonstrate a safe driving history and meet all regulatory requirements applicable to motor carriers.

---

### **b. Criminal Background Checks (52 Pa Code §29.505 – Criminal History)**

#### **i. How Background Checks Will Be Conducted:**

Criminal background checks will be conducted through a third-party background screening provider approved to conduct national and state criminal record checks. The checks will include county, state, and federal databases where available.

#### **ii. Frequency of Background Checks:**

A criminal background check will be conducted prior to hiring and periodically every two (2) years thereafter during employment.

#### **iii. Disqualifying Criminal History:**

Applicants may be disqualified for employment if their background check reveals serious offenses including but not limited to:

- Violent crimes (assault, robbery, homicide)
- Sexual offenses
- Drug trafficking or distribution
- Fraud or theft involving vulnerable persons
- Driving offenses involving DUI or reckless endangerment of passengers

The company reserves the right to review criminal records on a case-by-case basis while prioritizing passenger safety.

#### **iv. Record Retention:**

Records of all criminal background checks will be maintained electronically and/or in secure physical files by Star Medical Transportation Company for a minimum of five (5) years or for the duration of employment, whichever is longer.

---

### **c. Driver Training Program**

All drivers employed by Star Medical Transportation Company will participate in a structured training program prior to transporting passengers.

#### **i. Training Includes:**

- Orientation on company policies and passenger safety procedures
- Training in assisting passengers with mobility limitations
- Defensive driving training
- Passenger sensitivity and customer service training
- Emergency procedures and incident reporting

Drivers will also complete on-the-road training with an experienced trainer before operating independently.

---

### **d. Driver License / History Checks (52 Pa Code §29.504 – Driver History)**

#### **i. How Checks Will Be Performed:**

Driver license and driving history checks will be conducted through the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation (PennDOT) driver record system or a qualified third-party motor vehicle record provider.

#### **ii. Frequency of Checks:**

- At the time of hiring
- Annually thereafter

#### **iii. Record Retention:**

Copies of driver history reports will be maintained in the driver's personnel file for a minimum of five (5) years and stored securely.

## **2. Periodic Vehicle Maintenance Plan**

Star Medical Transportation Company will implement a comprehensive maintenance program to ensure all vehicles remain safe and compliant with regulatory standards.

### **a. Regular Maintenance**

Vehicles will receive regular maintenance including:

- Oil and filter changes
  - Tire inspections and rotations
  - Brake system inspections
  - Fluid level checks (transmission, coolant, brake, power steering)
  - Battery and electrical system checks
  - Inspection of wheelchair lifts and safety restraints (if applicable)
- 

### **b. Maintenance Schedule**

Maintenance will be performed according to the following schedule:

- Oil changes: Every 5,000–7,500 miles
- Full vehicle inspection: Every 6 months
- Brake inspection: Every 10,000 miles or as needed
- Wheelchair lift inspections: Quarterly
- Annual full safety inspection in accordance with Pennsylvania regulations

All maintenance will be performed by licensed automotive technicians and documented in vehicle maintenance logs.

---

### **c. Pre-Trip and Post-Trip Inspections**

Yes. Drivers will perform pre-trip and post-trip inspections for each vehicle before and after operating the vehicle.

These inspections will include:

- Checking tires and brakes
- Verifying lights and signals are operational
- Ensuring seat belts and safety equipment are functional
- Confirming wheelchair lifts and restraints are properly working

- Checking fluid levels and any visible vehicle damage

Drivers will document inspections in vehicle inspection logs, which will be maintained by the company.

Star Medical Transportation Company is a newly formed entity and has not yet begun operations. Currently, the company does not currently hold any vehicles in the name of the corporation. One motor vehicle intended for use in operations is currently owned personally by the owner and will be transferred, titled, registered, and insured in the name of Star Medical Transportation Company prior to commencement of service.

The company is in the process of establishing corporate banking relationships and acquiring the necessary vehicles and equipment required for operations. Once funding and equipment are secured, all assets will be registered and maintained in the name of Star Medical Transportation Company.

Vehicles owned by the corporation: None at this time

- Corporate liabilities or loans: None at this time

The company understands the Commission's requirement that assets, bank accounts, and vehicles must be held in the name of the corporation and will ensure full compliance prior to commencing operations. The company will not begin providing transportation services until all Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission regulatory requirements, including insurance filings under 52 Pa Code Chapter 32, have been satisfied.

Supporting documentation will be provided once the company has fully funded the corporate bank account and completed the transfer and registration of operational vehicles.
