

Pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 5.222 and the Prehearing Conference Order in this proceeding issued February 19, 2026, Penn Renewables LLC (“Penn Renewables”), by and through its undersigned counsel, hereby file this Prehearing Conference Memorandum.

I. INTRODUCTION

On February 3, 2026, FirstEnergy Pennsylvania Electric Company (“FE”) filed a Petition for Approval of Its Default Service Program for the Period June 1, 2027 to May 31, 2031 (“DSP VII Petition”) pursuant to Section 2807(e) of the Public Utility Code. In a petition to intervene submitted on February 19, 2026, Penn Renewables seeks to become a party to this proceeding, to ensure that its interest as a developer of solar photovoltaic net metering projects that have or will be interconnecting with the FE’s distribution systems is adequately represented. Penn Renewables intends to call into the initial prehearing conference scheduled for March 19, 2026.

III. ANTICIPATED ISSUES

Penn Renewables is at this time still formulating its positions on the issues presented by the DSP VII Petition. Based on preliminary review, Penn Renewables expects that potential issues will include, *inter alia*, the manner in which FE is proposing to conduct default service procurements for various customer classes under the DSP VII Petition, including but not limited to the structure of FE's proposed treatment of requirements under the Alternative Energy Portfolio Standards Act. Penn Renewables reserves the right to address other issues as it deems appropriate.

IV. PROPOSED WITNESSES

Penn Renewables is evaluating whether they will sponsor testimony in this proceeding. If Penn Renewables decides to sponsor testimony, it will inform the parties and the ALJs of any intended witnesses and topics of testimony. Penn Renewables also intend to participate in this proceeding through the submission of discovery, cross-examination of other parties' witnesses, and the submission of briefs, exceptions, and reply exceptions, if necessary.

V. PROPOSED SCHEDULE AND DISCOVERY RULES


