Dear Attorney O'Dell:

On March 6, 2026, The Pittsburgh Water and Sewer Authority (the Company) filed Supplement No. 18 to Water - Pa. P.U.C. No. 1, Supplement No. 17 to Wastewater - Pa. P.U.C. No. 1, and Supplement No. 9 to Storm Water - Pa. P.U.C. No. 1 (PWSA Supplements) to become effective on March 8, 2026. The PWSA Supplements were filed in compliance with the Commission's Opinion and Order entered February 19, 2026 at Docket Nos. R-2025-3055010 *et al.*, and contains rates, rules and regulations set forth in Appendices I, J, and K to the Joint Petition for Settlement with the modifications from the Commission's Opinion and Order. On March 12, 2026, the Company filed corrected tariff supplements to make minor language and formatting corrections.

Commission Staff has reviewed the tariff revisions and found that suspension or further investigation does not appear warranted at this time. Therefore, in accordance with 52 Pa. Code Chapter 53, the PWSA Supplements are effective by operation of law as of the effective date contained on each page of the supplements. However, this is without prejudice to any formal complaints timely filed against said tariff revisions.
