RESPONSE: Enel X does not have any financial interest in any suppliers participating in the NYISO market. Enel X does conduct business in the NYISO markets as an energy advisor/broker to customers who purchase energy in the NYISO market. In some instances, Enel X is compensated for their advisory and broker services provided to customers through an adder fee that is paid directly to Enel X by suppliers. Under this arrangement, Enel X does have agreements with suppliers who agree to pay the Enel X's adder fee directly to Enel X. Enel X conducts business as an independent advisor to its customers and thus does not favor any supplier. Enel X's adder fee is fully disclosed to all parties and is the same regardless of supplier chosen by the customer.

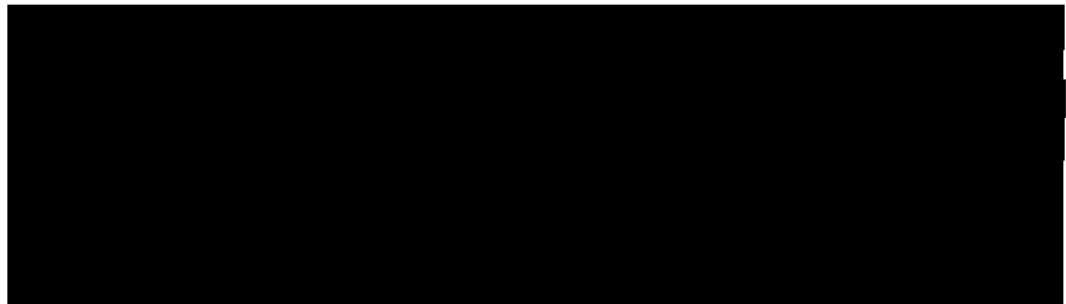
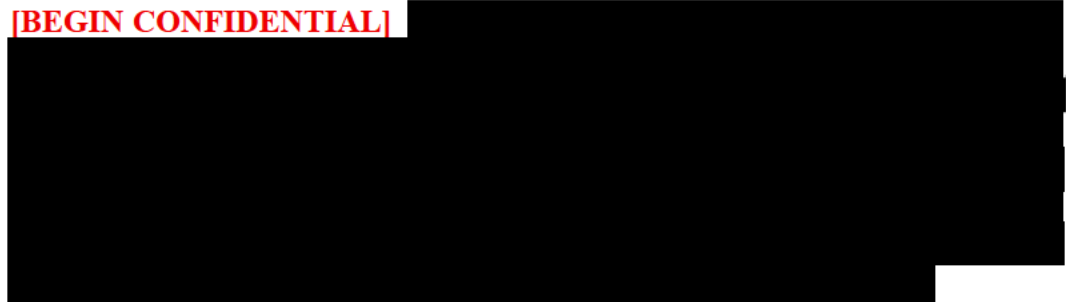


RESPONSE: Enel X will utilize its online platform (Enel X Exchange) to solicit and receive supplier price offers. The platform provides full transparency in terms of the solicitation content (RFP) sent out to suppliers, any Q&A follow ups with suppliers and a record of the supplier bids. Pike will be provided online access to the supplier bids received in real time and print outs of the bid history and results will be provided. Enel X's Exchange has been active for over 20 years and we currently serve nearly 150 clients, including utilities, Federal Government General Services Administration, State and Local governments, manufacturers, institutional and commercial customers. The Exchange is also used by the States who participate in the Regional Greenhouse Gas Initiative (RGGI) to procure RGGI credits. Our procurement customers have awarded annual supply contracts for more than 400 terawatt hours (TWh), nearly 2.4 billion dekatherms (Dth) of natural gas, and 6.4 million MWhs of renewable energy via power purchase agreements (PPAs). The Enel X Exchange is in full compliance with the Federal Risk and Authorization Management Program (FedRAMP). FedRAMP is a government-wide program (established in 2011, mandated by law in 2022) providing a standardized approach to security assessment, authorization, and continuous monitoring for cloud products used by federal agencies. It ensures rigorous security standards, saves resources, and streamlines adoption.
