**MOTION OF FIRSTENERGY PENNSYLVANIA ELECTRIC COMPANY
TO FILE ANSWER NUNC PRO TUNC**

TO THE PENNSYLVANIA PUBLIC UTILITY COMMISSION:

AND NOW, FirstEnergy Pennsylvania Electric Company (“FE PA” or the “Company”) by and through Angelina Umstead, respectfully petitions the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission's (“Commission”) to accept the Answer to the Formal Complaint of Edward Koprowicz being electronically filed contemporaneously with this Motion pursuant to 52 Pa. Code §§ 1.2, 5.62 and 5.103, as follows:

1. On February 27, 2026, Edward Koprowicz (“Complainant”) filed a Formal Complaint against the Company with the Commission.
2. Pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 5.61, the Company’s Answer to the Formal Complaint was due for filing on or before Thursday, March 19, 2026.
3. Due to an administrative oversight, the Answer was not timely filed with the Commission’s Secretary’s Bureau.
4. The Company respectfully requests that this Honorable Commission accept the filing of its Answer *nunc pro tunc*.
5. 52 Pa. Code § 1.1 et seq. governs rules of administrative practice and procedure before the Public Utility Commission.

6. 52 Pa. Code § 1.2 states that the procedural rules of Title 52 shall be liberally construed to secure the just, speedy and inexpensive determination of every action or proceeding to which it is applicable.

7. Furthermore, the Pennsylvania Commonwealth Court has held that the Commission has authority to waive procedural defects when they do not affect the substantive rights of the parties.¹

8. The Company respectfully submits that the late filing of its Answer was due to administrative oversight.


9. More importantly, acceptance of the Answer *nunc pro tunc* does not affect the substantive rights of the Complainant in this matter.

10. Accordingly, the Company respectfully requests that its Answer be accepted for filing *nunc pro tunc* so that this matter can be decided on the merits.


