Re: Amended Affiliated Interest Agreement – Peoples Natural Gas Company LLC –  
Service Agreement with PNG Companies LLC

Dear Ms. Moore:

On January 27, 2026, Peoples Natural Gas Company LLC (Peoples) filed with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission), pursuant to 66 Pa. C.S. §§ 2102, *et seq.*, the above-referenced Amendment to its Affiliated Interest Agreement (Agreement or AIA). By Secretarial Letter dated January 28, 2026, the Commission extended the statutory consideration period for this Agreement until further action of the Commission.

The proposed Amendment seeks Commission approval for Peoples to make minor changes to its 2023 AIA Service Agreement with PNG Companies LLC (PNG) that was approved by the Commission on March 8, 2023, at Docket No. G-2022-3036720.


Peoples is a public utility that provides natural gas service to approximately 700,000 customers in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. Peoples is a wholly owned direct subsidiary of PNG. PNG, a Delaware LLC, is a wholly owned subsidiary of LDC Funding LLC, which is a wholly owned direct subsidiary of Essential Utilities, Inc.

Peoples is seeking the Commission's approval to amend the 2023 AIA with minor changes that include: an update to the Organizational Chart and Exhibit C that amends the list of Non-Party Affiliates who have contracted to receive services with PNG, the addition of Clearfield County as a service area, and an update to reflect Peoples' current legal name. The Non-Party Affiliates are clearly identified in Exhibit A and C.

This Amended Agreement will become effective once approved by the Commission and shall continue until terminated by any party giving the other parties one-year written notice of termination or it will terminate immediately if any party ceases to be affiliated with the other party.

Upon review of the filing, it does not appear that this Agreement is unreasonable or contrary to the public interest. Therefore, this filing is hereby approved. This approval will apply only to the agreement, services, matters, and parties specifically and clearly defined under this instant proceeding as well as under any associated and previously filed filings. However, approval of this filing does not constitute a determination that the associated costs or expenses are reasonable or prudent for the purposes of determining just and reasonable rates. Furthermore, the Commission's approval is contingent upon the possibility that subsequent audits, reviews and inquiries in any Commission proceeding may be conducted, pursuant to 66 Pa. C.S. §§ 2102, *et seq.*
