Community Giving Update

Veolia is proud to report that in 2025, \$51,500 was distributed across Veolia's major service areas: Harrisburg, Mechanicsburg & Bloomsburg. Veolia Pennsylvania continues to prioritize community engagement, customer relationships, and local non-profit support.

2025 Support:

- > **Salvation Army Harrisburg Capital City Region: \$15,000**
Veolia continues its longstanding support of the Salvation Army and their efforts to ensure clients have access to fresh produce. The \$15,000 contribution supports the community garden operation, which includes over 40 raised garden beds along with small greenhouses. The Salvation Army grows thousands of pounds of produce each year, supporting their Nutrition Pantry, reducing food insecurity, and providing educational programs focused on healthy food choices. The Salvation Army remains a valued partner in helping Veolia promote the Customer Assistance Program for low-income customers. Veolia staff continue to volunteer by assisting with the raised beds, serving lunch at Summer Camp, and participating in the annual Youth Job Fair.
- > **Manada Conservancy: \$10,000**
Veolia is proud to continue its support of the Manada Conservancy, who serves as a dedicated steward of the Swatara Creek — the source water for Veolia's Hummelstown Plant. This contribution supports the work of the Stewardship Team, who work diligently to create healthy creekside buffers to absorb pollutants, create wildlife habitats, and greatly reduce flooding, all of which directly benefit Veolia's operations. These efforts mirror Veolia's purpose to contribute to human progress by committing to sustainable development goals and resourcing the world through environmental partnerships. Veolia staff continue to engage with the Conservancy through the annual Earth Day Clean Up.
- > **City and State PA: \$5,500**
Veolia supported City and State PA, a leading media organization covering Pennsylvania politics and policy.
