Request for Information

1.) For the Public Utility Commission to get a better understanding of your overall business concept.

A.) Please clarify as to who will be paying for the transportation services such as the individual rider or a school district.

Transportation services will be paid directly by the individual passenger or the passenger's parent or guardian.

B.) Please give an explanation if you are/will be under contract transporting students with a school district for all your proposed trips.

No, transportation services will be paid directly by the individual passenger or the passenger's parent or guardian.

C.) If applicable, provide signed contracts with your response.

2.) Question #10 of the application.

Language such as "50-mile radius of Wilkes-Barre, Pennsylvania" is unacceptable and insufficiently specific. The description of the authority needs to have clear boundaries usually requested by county/counties only, keeping with the Commission's criteria in mind. The territory needs to be clear and concise. Revise your territory request to indicate only the area from which county(s) you intend to originate service. The request should be

to provide transportation from those specific county(s) to points in Pennsylvania, and return. Revise your territory or advise the below example is now what you intend.

Example:

To transport persons, by motor vehicle, in Paratransit service, from Luzerne County, to points in Pennsylvania, and return. – This would be the correct answer.

- This territory means that you are not limited to a type of activity. This language would give your company the broadest customer base to work with.
- Please reference the attached list of territory/service templates on the last pages of this data request for proper verbiage.

To transport persons, by motor vehicle, in Paratransit service, from Luzerne County, to points in Pennsylvania, and return.

3.) Question #3 of the Verified Statement.

Please provide a complete description of Anyeline Paulino's previous experience, such as what Anyeline Paulino's daily duties were. Provide the transport company's full name, the licensing authority, along with the authority numbers.

Anyeline Paulino has prior experience in student transportation services as well as a background in business and management. From 2020 to 2023, she worked for a transportation company providing student transportation services. Her daily responsibilities included safely transporting students to and from school, assisting children with special needs, maintaining reliable pick-up and drop-off schedules, communicating with parents and school personnel, and coordinating transportation logistics such as routes and scheduling. Through this experience, she developed practical knowledge of passenger safety, time management, and the operational responsibilities required to provide dependable transportation services.

In addition to her transportation experience, Anyeline Paulino has an educational background in business. She holds a Bachelor's degree in Marketing from the Dominican Republic and an Associate's degree in Business Management from Luzerne County Community College. This academic background has provided her with knowledge in business operations, organization, customer service, and management practices. She is also a shareholder of Minyety Properties LLC, which has further contributed to her understanding of business administration and operational management. Combined, her hands-on experience in transportation services and her business education have prepared her to manage and operate a responsible and reliable passenger transportation service.

4.) Question #5 of the Verified Statement.

Provide compliant policies that satisfy the requirements of 52 Pa Code with revision to the specific chapters below. Please review Title 52 information online, which may be accessed at www.pacode.com.

A.) § 29.504. Driver History. How often will driver license checks be done after the initial check?

Driver History

The company will obtain and review a driver history report for each driver from the appropriate state licensing agency prior to permitting the driver to operate a vehicle. After the initial review, driver license history checks will be conducted at least once every 12 months to ensure that each driver maintains a valid driver's license and continues to meet all safety requirements. Copies of the driver history reports will be maintained in company records in accordance with regulatory requirements.

B.) § 29.505. Criminal history. After the initial check, how often will record checks be done and what are the disqualifications of employment?

Prior to employment, the company will obtain and review a criminal history record from the Pennsylvania State Police and any other state in which the driver has resided within the previous 12 months. After the initial background check, criminal history record checks will be conducted every two (2) years. A driver will be disqualified from employment if convicted of a felony or misdemeanor offense that relates adversely to the individual's ability to safely and legally provide transportation services. Records of criminal history checks will be maintained in company files as required by regulation

5.) Financial Position.

To fully assist the Commission in determining financial fitness please submit copies of the claimed vehicles' registration and/or title and a recent bank account statement, **ALL** in the name of MINYETY TRANSPORTATION SERVICES

LLC. The bank statement(s) account numbers may be redacted. You may choose instead to submit a notarized/official statement(s). Please make sure the bank officer contact information is current.

- It is expected that the applicant's account of (of MINYETY TRANSPORTATION SERVICES LLC) is filled and ready to commence operations with the ability to provide safe, efficient, and reliable service. Any assets which may need transferred to the applicant should happen NOW.

Regarding the financial position requirement outlined in section 5, MINYETY TRANSPORTATION SERVICES LLC is hereby submitting the required bank account statement in the company's name. With respect to the vehicle registration and/or title documentation, please be advised that the claimed vehicles are currently titled under the name of Anyeline Paulino, the sole owner and principal of the company. Should the Commission require said documentation at a later stage, we will promptly provide the corresponding evidence at that time.

Please find enclosed the bank account statement for MINYETY TRANSPORTATION SERVICES LLC as supporting documentation of the company's financial position.

Note: It is the responsibility of the applicant seeking motor common carrier authority to demonstrate that it possesses the financial ability to provide the proposed service. As per 52 Pa. Code §41.14, applications may be denied if the applicant fails to satisfy fitness standards. Be advised that additional corrections may not always be requested; therefore, prior to submitting your responses, your consultation with an attorney or financial expert familiar with Commission regulated Motor Carrier-related proceedings is highly encouraged. It is in your best interest to provide accurate, complete, and timely responses.

PASSENGER CARRIER TERRITORY EXAMPLES AND EXPLANATIONS:

The Public Utility Commission is specifically concerned with the location in which trips by your company will ORIGINATE. Your requested territory must have boundaries and are typically requested by County / Counties.

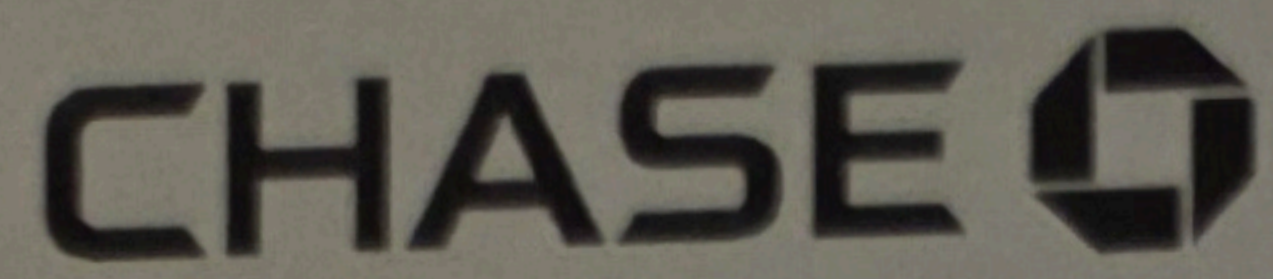
2) To transport persons, by motor vehicles, in Paratransit service, in wheelchair vans, between points in (County name/names here).

This territory means that you must:

- a) provide all services in wheelchair vans, and
- b) could travel only between points within the county or counties requested as your territory. You could not leave those counties and return.

3) To transport persons, by motor vehicle, in Paratransit service, limited to persons whose personal convictions prevent them from owning or operating motor vehicles, from points in (County name/names here), to points in Pennsylvania, and return.

This language is strictly for companies that specialize in transporting Amish people, this is NOT to be used for persons who are elderly and cannot drive, or who do not have a vehicle for any other reason.
