Request for Information

- 1.) Regarding question #10 of the application for your proposed service area: PUC regulates point-to-point transportation within Pennsylvania (INTRASTATE authority). Should it be granted, it gives no rights beyond state lines. You would have to acquire separate INTERSTATE authority from the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration. No mention of interstate travel can be mentioned in your authority as that is not PUC related.

- 2.) Question # 3 of the Verified Statement was missing the verifiable evidence. Typical submitted evidence is years' worth of paychecks, customer satisfaction for services rendered (showing now break in service), a letter written on the qualifying employer's letterhead. This letter should be dated, include periods of your employment, work responsibilities, a signature by a previous company manager in accordance with 18 Pa.C.S. § 4904 (relating to unsworn falsification to authorities).

Example:

I understand that the statements herein are made subject to the penalties of 18 Pa.C.S. § 4904 (relating to unsworn falsification to authorities).

Note: Additional methods of evidence may also be accepted; however, establishing verifiable proof is key.

3.) Question # 4 of the Verified Statement.

A.) Please provide a clear description of where your vehicle will be parked in relation to the physical address.

B.) What are the plans for storing a shipper's goods, if the move cannot be completed in one day?

C.) Please explain your plan to protect office records.

4.) Question # 5 of the Verified Statement.

Please review the requirements of the following chapters of 52 Pa Code and provide a required plan for drivers that fully demonstrates compliance with the below cited statutes in case of expansion. This is not optional.

A.) 52 Pa Code § 31.134 - Criminal history. (Frequency of record check, disqualification of employment, and record retention).

B.) 52 Pa Code § 37.204, 49 CFR 391.25 – Review of driver record. (schedule)

Does your vehicle maintenance plan involve trip inspections. Please describe your process. If available, submit documents that might be used for this type of inspection.

5.) Question # 8 of the Verified Statement. What is the total cost for six months of coverage? If it is not paid up front, what is the monthly installment amount?

6.) The Statement of Financial Position (Balance Sheet).

A.) Revise, date and improve the balance sheet. A review of the balance sheet indicates that the total liabilities far exceed the liquid assets. The record demonstrates that the applicant does not have sufficient capital necessary. Information should consist of accurate information and not rounded numbers or estimates. The information provided is also to be strictly limited to assets and debts held by the applicant (Lionheart Moving Company), and not the individual member(s). Any property listed must be registered or titled to the corporation – personal property should not be included.

B.) To fully assist the Commission in determining your financial fitness, please provide supporting documentation for the statement of financial position (balance sheet).

Acceptable means of support include current copies of bank statements (account

- numbers may be redacted), and notarized/official statements of account balances/ownership provided by bank officers (with current contact information).
- If the applicant was previously unfunded, then NOW is the time for the applicant's accounts to be filled.

C.) You must provide proof of ownership/registration in the name of Lionheart Moving Company for claimed vehicles.

7.) Are you familiar with the unique set up of a PA tariff with the weight and mileage chart (no binding estimates)?

Note: It is the responsibility of the applicant seeking motor common carrier authority to demonstrate that it possesses the financial ability to provide the proposed service. As per 52 Pa. Code §41.14, applications may be denied if the applicant fails to satisfy fitness standards. Be advised that additional corrections may not always be requested; therefore, prior to submitting your responses, your consultation with an attorney or financial expert familiar with Commission regulated Motor Carrier-related proceedings is highly encouraged. It is in your best interest to provide accurate, complete, and timely responses.
