RE: Review Of Utility Performance in Response to March 13, 2026, Windstorms

Dear Mr. Young:

The Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission's (Commission's) Bureau of Technical Utility Services (TUS) is requesting information regarding FirstEnergy Pennsylvania Electric Company's (FE's) response to a March 13, 2026, windstorms that caused reportable electric service interruptions to DLC customers pursuant to 52 Pa Code § 67.1.

Pursuant to Section 504 of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa.C.S. § 504, the Commission may require any public utility to file with it special reports concerning any matter whatsoever about which the commission is authorized to inquire, or to keep itself informed, or which it is required to enforce. To assist the Commission in its continued review of FE's response to the high number of service outages due to the March 13, 2026, storms, please respond for each applicable FE rate district with the information requested in Attachment 1. To reduce administrative burden, FE may include its response as an attachment or addendum to its required Report of Outage Form, pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 67.1(b), for each applicable rate district, and we hereby extend the due date of the service outage report(s) for each applicable rate district to thirty (30) days from the date of this letter.

Please provide your response to the Secretary of the Commission at the address listed below **within thirty (30) days** from the date of this letter. All documents requiring notary stamps must have original signatures. The Commission strongly encourages submission through eFiling with the Secretary of the Commission by opening an eFiling account through the Commission website and accepting eservice at <https://efiling.puc.pa.gov>. The Commission is accepting all public documents through our eFiling system at this time.

If your filing contains confidential material, you are required to either file by overnight delivery or submit it to the Secretary's Share Point File system to ensure the timely filing of your submission. Filers should contact the Secretary's Bureau in advance to gain access to the Share Point File system. Make sure to reference the Docket Number listed above when filing your response. Provide this information by each individual workday and not in the aggregate. Also list the personnel by specific job function, such as linemen, troublemen, damage assessors, forestry, flagmen, etc. Provide the requested information using an Excel table similar in form to the Excel template attached below.
- M-2. As a subset of information provided in the Report of Outage Form Part 5(e) (outage cases exceeding six or more hours in duration), for each applicable rate district, provide a separate table with information for each outage case that exceeded 72 hours in duration, and in addition to the information required in 5(e), provide the following information for those outage cases that exceeded 72 hours in duration:
- a. Describe any issues that caused the outage duration to be of an extended nature, such as access issues (on and off-ROW), damages to customer equipment or third-party equipment, emergency responder directives, etc.
 - b. Describe any proactive and/or continuing communication from your organization to: the impacted customers; local and/or county emergency response officials; and local and/or state elected officials.
- M-3. Please provide details on the preparations your organization undertook for the expected storms and high winds on March 13, 2026, including any outage prediction modelling or systems used to estimate potential impacts of the high wind event. Compare the results of any models used to the actual impacts. Also describe how your organization requested and onboarded any outside assistance, including contractors and other mutual aid, and the dates and times such outreach occurred.
