**INTERIM ORDER
DIRECTING COMPLAINANT TO PRODUCE
PROTECTION FROM ABUSE ORDER**

The Complainant, Kristine Cardaci (Complainant) filed a formal complaint against PPL Electric Utilities Corporation (PPL Electric) on July 23, 2025. In her complaint, Ms. Cardaci checked the box noting that a court has granted her a Protection from Abuse Order (PFA) for her personal safety or welfare. Accordingly, it is the practice of the Commission to protect the Complainant’s address, telephone number and account numbers in all filings that are typically made public.

The prehearing orders issued in this matter have included the following directive:

If you are a domestic violence victim and you want to be considered for protections that may be available to domestic violence victims, you must submit a copy of your Protection from Abuse (PFA) Order or other Court Order issued by a Pennsylvania court, which provides evidence that you are a domestic violence victim. You should mark this Order as “CONFIDENTIAL.”

Third Prehearing Order ¶ 6 (issued Feb. 9, 2026). As of the date of this interim order, the Complainant has not provided a PFA or other court-issued Order to support protected treatment in this proceeding.

A further telephonic hearing is scheduled in this matter for Wednesday, May 13, 2026, at 1:00 p.m.

THEREFORE,

IT IS ORDERED:

1. That until directed otherwise, the Complainant will continue to be given in this proceeding the protections accorded an individual having received a Protection from Abuse Order. Any filings made with the Commission shall protect the Complainant's address, telephone number, account number and any other identifying information.

2. That on or before **April 22, 2025**, the Complainant shall provide to me and counsel for PPL Electric a true and correct copy of a Court-issued Protection from Abuse Order or other Court Order issued by a Pennsylvania court, which provides clear evidence that you are a domestic violence victim. The court's Order must be currently in effect, or you must provide evidence of a pending court action to renew the Order.

3. That the Complainant shall mark as "CONFIDENTIAL" any materials provided pursuant to Ordering Paragraph 2, above.
