**Your answers should be verified per 52 Pa Code § 1.36.** Accordingly, you must provide the following statement with your responses:



Request for Information

- 1.) Your response to question #10 of the application is unacceptable. For scheduled route service you are expected to provide a complete written description for each route, to include the return. Provide an accompanying schedule which indicates the expected times for each stop, the route starts and stop times, and a legible official map demonstrating the route(s). This map should show all streets and exits traveled along this route. Typically, scheduled route service is provided in large vehicles such as buses. The schedule and the route do not allow for modifications without applying for additional authority from the Public Utility Commission.

**Note:** If you do not intend to operate in the manner described above, your proposed service would fall under the scope of Paratransit Authority. Submit a Paratransit application to include a cover letter referencing the docket number (A-2026-3061277) and this data request. This way the applicant would avoid another fee for the same open docket. Clearly state your intent to revise your authority and the following questions should be answered in full in the Paratransit application then. Please review the attached list of examples of paratransit carrier territories for guidance.

- 2.) Question #5 of the Verified Statement. You may always wish to operate as an owner-operator, but these questions are not optional. The Commission will not reevaluate your

hiring, employment standards and your knowledge of applicable laws, in case of expansion. Provide compliant policies that satisfy the requirements of 52 Pa Code with revision to the specific chapters below.

A.) § 29.504. Driver History. After the initial check, how often will driver license checks be done?

B.) § 29.505. Criminal history. How often will record checks be done and what are disqualifications of employment?

C.) Finally, explain your policy regarding your driving training program beyond saying that only will be offered and completed.

### 3.) Financial Position.

A.) Please verify that all assets and debts listed (for example: vehicle loan balances/vehicle asset value, etc.) in the submitted Statement of Financial Position (Balance Sheet) are held by the applicant (MI'ANGELS HANDS LLC) and not the member(s). Any property listed MUST be held to the company which is applying for authority. In your submission, you provided information which states the company owns land/building(s). We need to know if the applicant is co-mingling its assets/debts, which is not

permissible. If you have erroneously comingled the applicant's company assets/debts with those of the company member's personal assets/debts, then a revised, dated and improved Balance Sheet with an explanation of what was changed and why is required. The lack of funds indicated as shown on your balance sheet would not be sufficient for your company to be fit to operate.

- To show improved financial fitness you should show a substantial cash asset amount to cover any costs, vehicle maintenance, insurance coverage, assessments, or possible fines, etc. • Please ensure that the figures provided are accurate as of the date provided on the balance sheet, and that all figures provided are based on the best available information. The information is to be exact and should not include estimates or approximations when accurate numbers are available.

B.) Please provide supporting documentation for the improved balance sheet. Acceptable means of support include current copies of bank statements or notarized/official statements of account balances/ownership provided by bank officers (with current contact information) in the name of "MI'ANGELS HANDS LLC". (account numbers may be redacted).

- At this point it is expected that the applicant's account is now filled and ready to commence operations with the ability to provide safe, efficient, and reliable service.

C.) Submit proof of ownership of the claimed vehicles and the land/building, such as registrations, titles, purchase agreements, deeds, etc. All proof must be in the name of “MI'ANGELS HANDS LLC” or remove these personal items from the applicant’s Balance Sheet.

- Any assets which may need transferred to the applicant should happen prior to adding them to the balance sheet.

Note: It is the responsibility of the applicant seeking motor common carrier authority to demonstrate that it possesses the financial ability to provide the proposed service. As per 52 Pa. Code §41.14, applications may be denied if the applicant fails to satisfy fitness standards. Be advised that additional corrections may not always be requested; therefore, prior to submitting your responses, your consultation with an attorney or financial expert familiar with Commission regulated Motor Carrier-related proceedings is highly encouraged.

## **PARATRANSIT CARRIER TERRITORY EXAMPLES AND EXPLANATIONS:**

**The Public Utility Commission is specifically concerned with the location in which trips by your company will ORIGINATE. Your requested territory must have boundaries and are typically requested by County / Counties.**

**Take care in choosing the correct language. You must file a new application and pay an additional fee to amend any approved territory.**

**Examples below:**

1) To transport persons, by motor vehicle, in Paratransit service, from points in (County name/names here), to points in Pennsylvania, and return.

This territory means that you are not limited to a vehicle type, not limited to the type of activity regarding non-emergency medical transportation, or transportation for virtually any reason. This language would give your company the broadest customer base to work from.

2) To transport persons, by motor vehicles, in Paratransit service, in wheelchair vans, between points in (County name/names here).

This territory means that you must:

- a) provide all services in wheelchair vans, and
- b) could travel only between points within the county or counties requested as your territory. You could not leave those counties and return.

3) To transport persons, by motor vehicle, in Paratransit service, limited to persons whose

personal convictions prevent them from owning or operating motor vehicles, from points in (County name/names here), to points in Pennsylvania, and return.

This language is strictly for companies that specialize in transporting Amish people, this is NOT to be used for persons who are elderly and cannot drive, or who do not have a vehicle for any other reason.
