STATEMENT OF VICE CHAIR KIMBERLY BARROW

In our *Phase V Implementation Order*,¹ we stressed the importance of Pennsylvania electric distribution companies collaborating, rather than competing, with other program administrators. *Phase V Implementation Order* at 158-59, 166-68.

Consistent with the above directive above, PPL noted the Company and its selected conservation service provider will work with external program implementation vendors to ensure appropriate incentive allocation and minimize customer burden, including coordination with gas and water utilities and DEP-administered programs, and that the Company will share program and customer data, as directed by the Commission. PPL EE&C Plan at 196-97.

I commend the Company's commitment to work with other entities in compliance with our *Phase V Implementation Order*. I believe this coordination efforts will result in maximizing the impact of PPL's EE&C Plan.

Following the submittal and review of comments, on June 18, 2025, the Commission issued a Final Implementation Order at that same docket number (*Phase V Implementation Order*).
