To Whom It May Concern:

The purpose of this Letter is to advise you that your application has been reviewed and approved by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission). However, before beginning operations, you must file with the Commission all of the information listed in the paragraph(s) below. **You cannot operate under the approved motor carrier rights set forth in this Letter until all of the information listed below is filed with, and approved by, the Commission.** Once the information listed below is received and approved by the Commission, you will receive a license, with PUC No. A- 6328578, which authorizes you to begin operating under the rights set forth in this Letter.

- a) An acceptable Form E evidencing compliance with the Commission's insurance requirements and coverage amounts as set forth at 52 Pa. Code §32.11 and 41.21, *regardless* on any insurance coverage held independently by the carrier's drivers. Insurance filings are accepted online via Tyler Insurance Filings at [www.tylerinsurancefilings.com](http://www.tylerinsurancefilings.com)
- b) An acceptable tariff establishing just reasonable rates. Please e-mail a draft to [RA-tariff filings@pa.gov](mailto:RA-tariff filings@pa.gov). Do not E-file. Call (717) 214-7155 for assistance.

*Applicants are responsible for monitoring their account online. You can do this by visiting the following web address: <https://www.puc.pa.gov/search/utility-authority-search/>. Enter your company name, click submit, then click on your utility code hyperlink. Navigate to the "Insurance Info" tab, where you can view accepted forms.*

Upon issuance of a license, you will be granted the right to operate as follows:

*To transport persons in transportation network service between points in Pennsylvania, excluding service under the jurisdiction of the Philadelphia Parking Authority.*

**FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH ANY PROVISION OF THIS LETTER WITHIN SIXTY (60) DAYS OF THE DATE OF THIS LETTER WILL RESULT IN THE DISMISSAL OF THE APPLICATION AND REQUIRE THE FILING OF A NEW APPLICATION AND FILING FEE.**


The Commission also sets forth the following conditions:

1. That, as a condition of the license issued to Posh Rides Inc T/A Posh Rides, no contract or other agreement shall operate to eliminate, reduce or otherwise alter the consumer protections, driver integrity and vehicle safety requirements, or insurance requirements set forth in the Public Utility Code or the Commission's orders and regulations.
2. That, as a condition of Posh Rides Inc T/A Posh Rides, to the extent that Posh Rides Inc T/A Posh Rides uses any autonomous vehicles or vehicles with advanced driver assistance systems and technologies, such vehicles shall be and shall remain in continuous compliance with all current and future Pennsylvania Department of Transportation vehicle safety rules and regulations.
3. That, pursuant to Section 2610, Posh Rides Inc T/A Posh Rides shall report annually to the Commission its gross intrastate receipts derived from all fares charged to customers for the provision of transportation network service, which amount shall be the basis for its annual assessment in accordance with Section 510.
4. That Posh Rides Inc T/A Posh Rides shall comply with all requirements established by Act 164 and any conditions the Commission reasonably may impose.

Your client should become familiar with the requirements of 52 Pa. Code as applicable to the operation of a Transportation Network Company as authorized by this grant of authority. Any change in address must be reported to the Commission by filing a Change of Address Form. This form can be found on the Commission's website at: [https://www.puc.pa.gov/documents/utility-files/297/MC\\_Address\\_Change\\_011923.pdf](https://www.puc.pa.gov/documents/utility-files/297/MC_Address_Change_011923.pdf) Failure to comply with all applicable requirements may subject the carrier to penalties, including fines, suspension of operating rights or cancellation of authority. If you are dissatisfied with the resolution of this matter, you may, as set forth in 52 Pa. Code §5.44, file a petition with the Commission within twenty (20) days of the date of this Letter.
