**NOTICE OF CESSATION OF PIPELINE OPERATIONS**

VOG Field Services, LLC (“VOG”), by and through the undersigned, hereby provides this Notice of Cessation of Pipeline Operations to the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) and respectfully states as follows:

1. VOG is a previously registered pipeline operator under the provisions of Act 127 (66 Pa.C.S. §§ 501–508), with registration filed under the above-referenced docket.
2. The pipeline facilities associated with VOG’s Act 127 registration, consisting of gas gathering pipeline assets, have been fully decommissioned and are no longer in operation.
3. All abandonment and decommissioning activities were conducted in accordance with applicable federal pipeline safety regulations, including but not limited to **49 C.F.R. § 192.727** (Abandonment or deactivation of facilities).
4. In connection with the cessation of operations, VOG has taken appropriate steps to ensure the pipeline facilities were safely purged, disconnected, and rendered inactive in accordance with industry standards and regulatory expectations, including the disconnection of all sources of gas, sealing of the pipeline where appropriate, and elimination of potential hazards.
5. VOG has coordinated, as applicable, with the **Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA)** regarding its operator status and reporting obligations, including compliance with **49 C.F.R. Part 191** reporting requirements and updates to reflect the cessation of pipeline operations. VOG will continue to comply with any remaining federal requirements associated with inactive or abandoned facilities.
6. Consistent with Pennsylvania law, VOG acknowledges the Commission’s authority over pipeline safety enforcement under **52 Pa. Code Chapter 59** (Pipeline Safety) and Act 127, and submits this notice to ensure Commission records accurately reflect the operational status of its facilities.
7. As reflected in VOG’s most recent Annual Registration Form filed with the Commission, the pipeline system previously operated by VOG has ceased operations in its entirety .

8. VOG no longer owns or operates pipeline facilities in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania that are subject to Act 127 registration or reporting requirements.
9. There are no active customers, third-party connections, or ongoing transportation of gas associated with the decommissioned facilities.

**WHEREFORE, VOG Field Services, LLC respectfully requests that the Commission:**

- a. Acknowledge this Notice of Cessation of Pipeline Operations;
- b. Update its records to reflect that VOG is no longer an active pipeline operator under Act 127; and
- c. Confirm that no further annual registration filings are required unless operations resume.
