The Bureau of Audits has reviewed PPL Electric Utilities Corporation's proposed Supplement No. 413 to Tariff Electric – Pa. P.U.C. No. 201 and the supporting rate computations submitted on March 18, 2026 to become effective on April 1, 2026.

Based upon staff review, it appears that the proposed Smart Meter Rider Phase 2 (SMR-2) rates for the three-month period of April 1, 2026 through June 30, 2026 are consistent with the tariff and, accordingly, are permitted to become effective as filed.

The SMR-2 is subject to continuous Commission review and audit as well as reconciliation reports in accordance with Section 1307(e) of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. § 1307(e).

Pursuant to the Commission's regulations at 52 Pa. Code § 5.44 (relating to petitions for reconsideration from actions of the staff), you may appeal by filing a petition for reconsideration with the Commission within 20 days of the date of this letter.
