ORDER
GRANTING THE PETITION TO INTERVENE OF THE PROCTER & GAMBLE PAPER
PRODUCTS COMPANY

On February 6, 2026, UGI Utilities, Inc. – Gas Division (“UGI Gas”) filed an Application seeking approval pursuant to Sections 1102(a)(3), 1103(a), and 2102(b) of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Code (“Code”) to transfer the Auburn City Gate Stations located in Auburn Township, Susquehanna County, Pennsylvania, to UGI Auburn Gathering, LLC (“UGI Gathering”). UGI Gas also seeks approval of a modification of an existing affiliated interest agreement pursuant to Section 2103 of the Code.

Notice of the Application was published in the February 21, 2026, issue of the *Pennsylvania Bulletin*. The Notice indicated that formal protests and petitions to intervene to the Application were to be filed by March 9, 2026.

On March 9, 2026, UGI Gas filed a Letter wherein it agreed to extend the deadline for the Procter & Gamble Paper Products Company (“P&G”) to file an intervention or protest, from March 9, 2026, to April 8, 2026.

On March 9, 2026, P&G filed a Petition to Intervene.

The Commission has issued regulations governing various aspects of intervention in a Commission proceeding, including eligibility to file a petition to intervene and its required content. *See* 52 Pa. Code § 5.71- 5.73. A party may intervene where (1) there is a right to intervene conferred by statute, (2) there is an interest which may be directly affected and which is not adequately represented by existing participants, and as to which the petitioner may be bound by the action of the Commission in the proceeding, or (3) there is another interest of such nature that participation of the petitioner may be in the public interest. 52 Pa. Code § 5.72(a).

Notably, no party filed an Answer to P&G's Petition to Intervene within 20 days of service. *See* 52 Pa. Code § 5.66(a). P&G argued in its Petition that it has an interest in the proposed transfer of the Auburn City Gate Station as an industrial customer of UGI Gas that receives gas through the Auburn City Gate Station. I agree with P&G that it has an interest which may be directly affected and which is not adequately represented by existing participants, and as to which the petitioner may be bound by the action of the Commission in the proceeding. *See* 52 Pa. Code § 5.72(a)(2). Therefore, the Petition to Intervene of P&G will be granted in the Ordering paragraphs below.
