**TUS-1:** Reference Application – Section 4. Please clarify whether the two active customers referenced in the Application are served under the Small General Service (SGS) rate schedule. If not, please identify the specific tariff rate classification under which the customers receive service.

**Date:** March 31, 2026

**Response:** **Both active customers were being billed at the Small General Service (SGS) Rate**

**TUS-2:** Reference Application – Section 5. Please identify the tariff rate classification applicable to the two inactive or idle customer customers.

**Date:** March 31, 2026

**Response:** **It is unknown to Peoples what rate class the two idle customers were billed at when they were previously connected to service. Peoples reviewed records from its billing system for the two addresses as far back as it could go (January 1, 2012) and found no billing records for the properties. Furthermore, when the main line was replaced in March, 2012, both addresses were found to not have gas service and the service lines were cut and capped at the curb. It is unknown to Peoples the last time that active gas service was provided to each of the idle properties.**

**TUS-3:** Reference Application – Section 5. Please explain whether Peoples Gas discontinued billing the customers at the idle or inactive premises for the *customer charge* portion of the bill at the time service was discontinued on or about March 10, 2012. If applicable, please indicate the date on which Peoples Gas ceased billing the two inactive customers for the customer charge.

**Date:** March 31, 2026

**Response:** **See response to TUS-2 above. The last time the idle/inactive properties were billed is unknown.**

**TUS-4:** Reference Application – Section 5. Please clarify whether Peoples Gas provided the two idle or inactive customers with written notice or correspondence seeking consent or agreement regarding the proposed abandonment of natural gas service to the two premises. If not, please explain the company’s rationale for not obtaining written consent from the inactive customers.

**Date:** March 31, 2026

**Response:** Peoples did not provide notice to these properties as it had no record of either having had natural gas service as far back as data could be searched. Peoples sent a copy of its Application in this matter to each idle/inactive property via certified mail. Card receipts were received for each property, indicating that someone signed for and accepted the certified letters.

**TUS-5** Reference Application – Sections 4 and 9. In Attachment A, the company appears to indicate that the total revenue derived from the two active customers is \$3,140.72, while the Application states that the projected annual non-gas distribution revenue from the two active customers is \$1,786.09. Please reconcile these figures. Further, please provide a workpaper, with all assumptions and calculations shown, demonstrating how the company calculated:

- a) the non-gas distribution revenue based on the usage reflected in Attachment A; and
- b) the projected annual non-gas distribution revenue for the two active customers.

**Date:** March 31, 2026

**Response:** Please see the attached Worksheets. Peoples made a mathematical error in its calculation for the non-gas costs portions of the bills and that corrected projected non-gas revenue is \$1,722.29. As such, Peoples Paragraph 9 of its Application should have read as follows:

*Peoples estimates that the incremental investment to construct a new river crossing and to connect that crossing to the existing distribution facilities to continue service to the two (2) active Customers would result in a revenue deficiency of approximately \$29,631.22 per year. This figure is calculated as follows: First, Peoples would have to construct a new main and install a new POD at a cost of approximately \$286,751.41. Second, the resulting annual cost,*

*based on cost of capital, income taxes and depreciation, will be approximately \$31,353.51. To be economically justified, the line must provide at least this amount in annual non-gas distribution revenues. The active Customers consumed a combined total of 340.9 Mcf from April 2024-April 2025. Applying Peoples' currently effective base rates, including a customer charge of \$22.01 each, the total annual non-gas distribution revenue received by Peoples from the active Customer would be approximately \$1,722.29. Subtracting the \$1,722.29 total non-gas distribution revenue from the yearly revenue requirement of \$31,353.51 would result in a revenue deficiency of approximately \$29,631.22 per year.*

**For each active customer, Peoples used one year of service prior to the natural gas line being out of service as the baseline for its calculations. For each, the non-gas costs, which were the customer charge and the delivery charge, were segregated out from the total bills to come up with the annual non-gas revenue. For the projected annual non-gas distribution revenue, Peoples just used the current, in-place customer charge and delivery charge to calculate this amount. If future rate proceedings are filed and rates change, this amount will vary, but the revenue deficiency of approximately \$29,631.22 per year is not expected to fluctuate significantly.**
