The Bureau of Audits has reviewed National Fuel Gas Distribution Corporation's proposed Supplement No. 298 to Tariff Gas – Pa. P.U.C. No. 9 and the supporting rate computations submitted on March 20, 2026 and subsequently revised on March 30, 2026 to become effective on April 1, 2026.

Based upon staff review, it appears that the proposed Distribution System Improvement Charge (DSIC) rate for the three-month period of April 1, 2026 through June 30, 2026 is consistent with the tariff and, accordingly, is permitted to become effective as filed.

The DSIC is subject to continuous Commission review and audit as well as reconciliation reports in accordance with Section 1307(e) of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. § 1307(e).

Pursuant to the Commission's regulations at 52 Pa. Code § 5.44 (relating to petitions for reconsideration from actions of the staff), you may appeal by filing a petition for reconsideration with the Commission within 20 days of the date of this letter.
