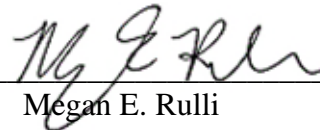

At this time, Columbia cannot provide any further identification of issues in this purchased gas cost proceeding. Columbia reserves the right to present additional witnesses, testimony and exhibits on all matters arising during the course of the proceeding, including all matters raised by other parties.

Columbia may amend its prefiled information, as appropriate, during the course of this proceeding, based upon more recent information, as such information becomes available. Such update(s) will reflect changes in information relevant to the determination of the proper level of purchased gas cost recovery rates to become effective October 1, 2026.

### Columbia's Proposal in This Proceeding

On February 27, 2026, Columbia filed with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission ("Commission") certain pre-filing data required under the Commission's regulations. On April 1,

2026, Columbia is filing with the Commission Supplement No. 415 to Tariff Gas Pa. P.U.C. No. 9, along with its definitive filing. Supplement No. 415 is to become effective for service rendered on and after October 1, 2026. In Supplement No. 415, Columbia proposes an increase in its rates for recovery of purchased gas costs of \$0.04740/Therm.

**Settlement**


To date, no settlement discussions have been held. However, Columbia will be working with the parties in an effort to resolve this proceeding through settlement.
