Dear Attorney Snyder:

On February 26, 2026, Pike County Light & Power Company (PCLP) filed its Annual Asset Optimization Plan (AAOP), for its electric operations, pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 121.6. Absent any major modifications to the Long-Term Infrastructure Improvement Plan or Commission action to reject an AAOP within 60 days of its submission to the Commission, the AAOP will be deemed approved. The Commission may extend its consideration period, if necessary, pursuant to 52 PA. Code § 121.6(e).

The Commission has delegated the review of AAOPs to the Bureau of Technical Utility Services (TUS). To complete the TUS review of PCLP’s AAOP, the Commission hereby extends the consideration period of PCLP’s AAOP to June 1, 2026.

If you are dissatisfied with the resolution of this matter, you may, as set forth in 52 Pa. Code § 5.44, file a petition with the Commission within twenty (20) days after the date of this letter. Please direct any questions regarding this filing to Clinton McKinley, TUS, at cmckinley@pa.gov.
