**PREHEARING CONFERENCE ORDER**

A Prehearing Conference is scheduled for **Tuesday, April 28, 2026, at 10:00 a.m.** To participate in the Conference, you must dial the toll-free number listed below. You must call into the Conference on the scheduled day and time. Failure of any party to attend the Prehearing Conference without good cause shall constitute a waiver of all objections to the agreements reached and matters decided at the Prehearing Conference. You will not be called by the Administrative Law Judge.

The parties are hereby directed to comply with the following requirements:

1. Each party must file and serve, **prior to 4:30 p.m. on Friday, April 24, 2026**, a Prehearing Conference Memorandum, to include:

- i. List of issues
- ii. List of witnesses
- iii. Proposed area of testimony of each identified witness, with an estimated length of direct testimony to be presented by each witness
- iv. Proposed procedural/litigation schedule to include availability for an in-person evidentiary hearing to be held in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania in June 2026
- v. Any other relevant issue identified by the parties

2. A request for a change of the scheduled Prehearing Conference date must state the agreement or opposition of other parties and must be submitted by email to the undersigned Administrative Law Judge at [efarren@pa.gov](mailto:efarren@pa.gov), **prior to 4:30 p.m. on Tuesday, April 21, 2026**. 52 Pa. Code § 1.15(b). Absent a continuance for good cause, all parties must be prepared to participate in the scheduled Prehearing Conference.

3. Parties are reminded that the Commission's regulations encourage parties to exchange information on an informal basis. All parties are urged to cooperate in discovery and advise at the Prehearing Conference as to discovery issues which have not been resolved. There are limitations on discovery and sanctions for abuse of the discovery process. 52 Pa. Code §§ 5.361, 5.371-5.372.

4. If you are an individual, you may represent yourself or you may be represented by an attorney licensed to practice law in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania or admitted *pro hac vice*. However, if you are a partnership, corporation, trust, association, or governmental agency or subdivision, you must be represented in this proceeding by an attorney licensed to practice law in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania or admitted *pro hac vice*.
