Dear Secretary Homsher:

In its Joint Settlement Agreement for the base rate case approved by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission on November 21, 2024, FirstEnergy Pennsylvania Electric Company (“FE PA” or the “Company”) agreed to certain reliability improvements and annual reporting.¹ Specifically, FE PA committed to a cumulative improvement in reliability that results in a reduction of the weighted average System Average Interruption Duration Index (“SAIDI”) by 3.5% and System Average Interruption Frequency Index (“SAIFI”) by 2.5% after three years following the effective date of rates implementing the base electric distribution revenue increase provided for in the agreement. The improvements are to be measured using actual year-ended December 31, 2027 performance results as compared to the three-year averages as published in the 2023 PUC Electric Reliability Report results, assuming similar weather for that three-year average time period. Consistent with this commitment, FE PA agreed to provide an annual report to the parties detailing its performance improvement data reflected in the same terms as will be measured for compliance by no later than April 1 each year.

In accordance with the terms set forth above, FE PA is submitting the following SAIDI and SAIFI metrics for 2025 as compared to the 2023 baseline for each of the rate districts as follows:

Met-Ed:

SAIFI increased 29% from **1.31 (2023 baseline)** to **1.69 (2025)**.

SAIDI increased 62% from **234 minutes (2023 baseline)** to **380 minutes (2025)**.

Penelec:

SAIFI improved 2% from **1.76 (2023 baseline)** to **1.72 (2025)**.

SAIDI improved 22% from **315 minutes (2023 baseline)** to **246 minutes (2025)**.

Penn Power:

SAIFI increased 29% from **0.92 (2023 baseline)** to **1.19 (2025)**.

SAIDI increased 9% from **128 minutes (2023 baseline)** to **139 minutes (2025)**.

West Penn:


SAIFI remained stable with a <1% increase of **1.22 (2023 baseline)** to **1.23 (2025)**.

SAIDI improved 16% from **297 minutes (2023 baseline)** to **248 minutes (2025)**.

In comparison to the 2023 baseline, the 2025 results reflect progress in two of the rate districts and highlight areas for improvement in the other two rate districts. FE PA remains committed to reliability improvement and continues to prioritize reliability-driven initiatives and investments in 2026 and beyond.


