On March 30, 2026, PECO Energy Company – Gas Division (“PECO”) filed Tariff No 7, which sets forth proposed rates, revisions, additions and deletions to PECO’s currently effective tariff.

On March 31, 2026, the Bureau of Technical Utility Services contacted counsel for PECO and noted that while the supporting documents of the filing enclosed and referenced Tariff No. 7, the first page of the cover letter accompanying the filing referenced Tariff No. 8. Pursuant to Section 1308 of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Code, enclosed for filing on behalf of PECO Energy Company (“PECO” or the “Company”) is a Certificate of Service evidencing filing of PECO’s Tariff Gas — Pa. P.U.C. No. 7 (“Tariff No. 7”), which has been uploaded to the Secretary’s SharePoint site due to its size. Tariff No. 7 sets forth proposed rates designed to produce an increase in the Company’s annual distribution revenue of approximately \$81 million based on data for a fully projected future test year ending December 31, 2027.

**CONTENTS OF THE FILING**

Tariff No. 7 contains revisions in, additions to, and deletions from certain Rules and Regulations, rate schedules, and riders in the Company’s currently effective tariff. Tariff No. 8 also bears an issue date of March 30, 2026, and an effective date of May 29, 2026.

Along with Tariff No. 7, the Company is filing all the supporting data required by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission’s (“PUC” or “Commission”) regulations at 52 Pa. Code §§ 53.52 — 53.53, including the written direct testimony of thirteen witnesses, who are
