PREHEARING ORDER FOR TELEPHONIC HEARING

AND NOW, this 7th day of April 2026, it is hereby ORDERED:

1. **DATE AND TIME OF HEARING.** A telephonic hearing will be held in this case on:

Friday, April 10, 2026, beginning at 9:00 AM

To participate in the hearing, you must dial the toll-free number listed below. You will be prompted to enter the Passcode Number, which is also listed below. You will be asked to speak your name, press the # key, and then the telephone system will connect you to the hearing. If you have any witnesses you want to have present during the hearing who are participating from a separate phone, you must provide them with the telephone number and Passcode Number.

2. **REPRESENTATION.** Although the caption of this matter reflects the Complainant as an individual, Tony Gardner, the Complaint and the Emergency Petition, indicate that the utility service at issue is a non-residential account with the account holder as “K Fish Comestible.” Tony Gardner signed the verification of the Complaint as “owner.” Based upon the foregoing representations, Tony Gardner averred that K Fish Comestible is a company. Sections 1.21 and 1.22 of Commission regulations require that K Fish Comestible must be represented in adversarial proceedings, such as, at the instant scheduled hearing, by an attorney licensed to practice law in Pennsylvania or admitted *pro hac vice*. 52 Pa. Code §§ 1.21, 1.22. Section 1.24 of Commission

regulations provides that an attorney shall file a written notice of appearance with the Commission's Secretary; this notice of appearance shall be contemporaneously served on opposing counsel and the undersigned Presiding Officer. 52 Pa. Code § 1.24. **Complainant will not be permitted to testify or otherwise present evidence at the hearing unless represented by an attorney.**

3. PRESENTING EXHIBITS. If you intend to present any documents or exhibits at the hearing, you must email one (1) copy to the Presiding Officer at efarren@pa.gov and one (1) copy each must be sent to every other party. All copies must be received by **Thursday, April 9, 2026, by 12:00 P.M.** Proposed exhibits should be properly pre-marked for identification purposes. Do not include account numbers or any other personally identifiable information (PII), such as social security numbers, in your documents or exhibits. It is the parties' responsibility to redact any PII contained within a document or exhibit before submitting it into the record. Do not file your proposed documents or exhibits with the Secretary's Bureau. However, you should file a Certificate of Service with the Secretary's Bureau indicating you sent the proposed documents or exhibits to every other party and the undersigned Presiding Officer.

4. FILING AND SERVING DOCUMENTS. When you file a document, you must provide the original to the Commission and serve a copy to the other party or parties and the undersigned Presiding Officer at efarren@pa.gov.

5. CONTACT INFORMATION. If your email address or telephone number changes during the course of the proceeding, you must immediately update the Office of Administrative Law Judge by calling 717-787-1399.

6. ACCOMMODATION. Any party who needs an accommodation for a disability in order to participate in this hearing process may request one. Please call the Office of Administrative Law Judge's scheduling office immediately to submit your request.
