**NOTICE OF PUBLIC INPUT HEARINGS**

**Application of Greater Hazleton Community Area New Development Organization, Inc. t/a CAN DO, Inc. (Water Division), Pursuant to Section 1102(a) of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Code for approval of (1) the Right to Offer, Render, Furnish or Supply Water Service to the Public in an Additional Portion of Hazle Township, together with Portions of Sugarloaf Township and West Hazleton Borough, all in Luzerne County, Pennsylvania and (2) the Abandonment of Portions of its Water Service Territory in Hazle Township, Luzerne County, Pennsylvania**

The Public Utility Commission (PUC) will hold telephonic public input hearings concerning an application filed by CAN DO, Inc. to (1) expand its service territory to allow it to provide water service to a proposed new data center; and (2) abandon portions of its water service territory.

Two public input hearings will be held as follows:

**Registration to speak at a public input hearing is encouraged but not required.** If you wish to testify, you are encouraged to pre-register with the Office of Administrative Law Judge by **4:00 P.M. on Monday, July 6, 2026.** Those who pre-register and provide the information listed below will be called to testify at the hearing in the order in which they pre-register. If you want to listen to a public input hearing (without testifying), you do not need to pre-register.

- (1) your first and last name,
- (2) the phone number you will be using to call into the public input hearing,

- (4) your email address, if you have one.

**Need assistance with pre-registration?** If you need assistance pre-registering to testify, you may have someone register for you, but they will need to provide all the information listed above. Additionally, if more than one person in your household would like to testify, one person may pre-register for other individuals in the same household by providing the PUC Judge's Legal Assistant with the above-listed information for each individual.

**Hearing exhibits:** If you have any hearing exhibits to which you will refer during the hearing, please email them to the Legal Assistant, at [sarcavanau@pa.gov](mailto:sarcavanau@pa.gov). The PUC Judge will forward your exhibits to all the parties.

- Exhibits must be received by the Legal Assistant by **Tuesday, June 30, 2026.**

**Requests for interpreters:** If you require an interpreter, please pre-register as soon as possible. If you register too close to the hearing date, we may not have enough time to arrange for an interpreter. If you request an interpreter, the PUC will make reasonable efforts to have one present.

**Accommodation for participating in telephonic public input hearings:** Persons with a hearing and/or speech impairment may dial 711 to use a TTY-based telecommunications relay service.
